First ERASMUS alumni meet in Pondicherry University



The Department of Management Studies (DMS), Pondicherry University has an active Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Koblenz University of Applied Sciences (RheinAhr Campus), Germany since 2020. This has so far supported 21 MBA students to do a semester abroad with an Erasmus scholarship from the European Union, covering all their expenses, including flights. During their exchange semesters in Germany, these students participated in GreenErasmus projects to promote sustainable and environmentally responsible businesses, completed internships in very international teams and even went on study tours to other European countries. Prof Laurence Borgmann, Director of International Affairs at Koblenz University of Applied Sciences, Germany had visited Pondicherry University from January to March 2024 to deliver special lectures on intercultural communication and also to promote 'Study in Germany' opportunities through this MOU.

The 'Returnees' who had benefitted from the Erasmus-funded 'semester abroad' opportunity met in DMS, Pondicherry University on February 24, 2024 for the first-ever Erasmus alumni meet. It turned out to be a

memorable homecoming for the alumni who spoke about how their semester abroad had prepared them for their current professional challenges and how it had opened up unique career opportunities to work with international teams. Learning to be independent, letting go of inhibitions, training to be decisive, adding new skills to their skill set, experiencing the German way of life and traveling around Europe were highlighted as key takeaways and memorable moments from the exchange semesters.

Speaking on the occasion, Prof Borgmann urged the alumni not to 'rest on their laurels' but to continue their personal internationalization journey which started during their semester abroad in Germany. He expressed immense satisfaction with this 'privileged partnership' with Pondicherry University that has sent the maximum number of exchange students to his German university till date. He also unveiled a "Roll of honour" board listing the names of all the 42 exchange students during 2019-2024 from DMS, Pondicherry University to international partner universities such as University of East Paris – France, Koblenz University of Applied Sciences – Germany and School of Management Fribourg, Switzerland.

After listening to the heart-warming success stories of the alumni, Prof Kasilingam, Head, Department of Management Studies thanked Prof Borgmann for the opportunity extended to the students and pointed out how their experience at his university has demonstrably enriched their personalities and career prospects. Prof Victor Anandkumar, the MOU Coordinator attributed the success of this Indo-German student exchange to the robust selection process to identify the right candidates who would benefit the most from this fully-funded international opportunity. He also mentioned that in a next step, the German partner university proposes a double-degree undergraduate program in the near future. Internationalization is a key thrust area for DMS, Pondicherry University and this Indo-German partnership has contributed to expanding the global footprint of Pondicherry University and to providing students with a fully-funded semester abroad opportunity in Germany.

2. The allotment of obsolete / Total Technical Life Expired (TTLE) airframe is governed by the provisions of Gol MoD letter Air HQ/60294/497/MC-2/187/SO(JB)/D(Air-IV)/16 dated 20 Jul 16 (copy of Gol letter is annexed for your ready reference). As per the existing guidelines, Pondicherry University, Puducherry falls under Category "D", being a 'Central/ State Govt Educational Institution/ College/ School and the main terms and conditions are as follows:-

(a) Allotment charges - Free issue.

(b) Transportation - Cost to be borne by IAF.

(c) Installation - Guidance will be provided by IAF representative.

(d) Other expenditure - Expenses towards installation, construction of platform and other infrastructure to be borne by the allottee.

(e) Maintenance - To be done by the allottee.

- 3. In order to complete the formalities of registration for allotment of obsolete/ TLE airframe, information is required as per Annexure-I of the Gol letter. The bona-fide of the University and the reasonableness of the requirements will have to be certified by the concerned Ministry/ Department of the Government of India or the State Government by an officer not below the rank of Joint Secretary in the Government of India.

Executive Summary

REPRESENTATIONS AND MEANINGS: A DECOLONIZING APPROACH IN ANTHROPOLOGY

Statement of Need:

Internationalizing strategies as well as joint co-operations on an international scale gain from a critical examination of the historical and ideological foundation of their mutual interactions and ideas. This is part of the recent decolonizing initiatives taking place in universities and beyond. Our aim in this project is to work out the potential of a decolonizing approach for anthropology in India and in Germany. We assume, that discussions about decolonization in general and in the university context in particular are necessary in order to create a reflective and critical awareness of past and present colonial knowledge policies and epistemologies within university practice. The colonial assumption of an a priori cultural and religious superiority (Bhambra et al. 2018, Mbembe 2016) legitimized the hegemonic conditions of colonialism. At the same time, this became an often un-reflected basis for the generation of knowledge at universities (Stoler 2016, Zimmermann 2001). Decolonial approaches go beyond postcolonial approaches by self-critically questioning the academic structures where knowledge is produced (Sanchez 2018) and by relating the colonial past to current scientific responsibility. This includes an insight into the extent to which universities and research institutions from the Global North and the Global South build on colonial epistemes in teaching and research and, with their privileged access to financial and intellectual resources, continue and reproduce existing Eurocentric knowledge traditions and research dynamics to this day. The challenge we are facing is to develop concepts for new, decolonial knowledge orders. The programs and activities regarding 'decolonisation' are different depending on their historical and geographical positions. In this program, we are eager to discuss 'decolonisation' from different perspectives (e.g. Global South/North, academics/non-academics) in order to not fall into the trap of yet another Eurocentric perspective.

We want to interactively address this challenge by developing jointly new teaching and research practices. By bringing together students from the Global North and the Global South we will enable students to raise critical reflections on Eurocentric knowledge productions and viewpoints, assess our respective positions and investigate our particular socialization into academia asking, what relevance they have for the epistemologies that we take for granted?

Disciplinary Focus:

Bringing together our specific expertise we will concentrate on two topics:

1. Representations of the 'cultural other' in the ethnographic museum and collections

2. 'Development and Resistence': Unpacking the meanings in Adivasi/tribal contexts

Representations of the 'cultural other' in the ethnographic museum and collections

The beginnings of Anthropology as a discipline are closely related to the collection of ethnographic objects that were displayed in the newly erected museums starting at the end of the 19th century, with objects from which, many were collected within the colonial period under colonial epistemologies. Until today the ethnographic museums and collections play a major role in the transmission of concepts and tropes of what 'other cultures' are. The collecting practices as well as the representations are deeply interwoven with colonial ideas of supremacy, (evolutionary) progress and orientalism. Over the last decade museums worldwide have critically questioned their own past and thrived to establish new forms of representation. One of the pressing questions is how museums can and should react to the challenge to decolonize their practices and collections and to respond to the changing cultural landscapes and identities. What is the responsibility of the museums towards the people, cultures, religions that are represented there, and what are the responsibilities towards the material objects assembled there? Where do the objects rightfully belong, how and by whom should they be used and managed? What kinds of knowledge are stored in these objects - and how much of colonial ideologies are involved in past and current practices of knowledge production. These are the questions we want to discuss and actively engage with together with curators, museum staff, students and teachers.

'Development and Resistence': Unpacking the meanings in Adivasi/tribal contexts

In understanding and using a decolonial approach, the research and teaching for this project will also focus on one Indian constitutional category of people, the Scheduled Tribes. This category of people, addressed by themselves as adivasi/tribe, suffer from the colonial construction of their identity that is resilient till date. The project will put together a people's perspective to identity and look beyond colonial constructions of 'primitive', 'savage' and 'backward' that continue to dominate and inform nationalist agendas of development (Kuper, 1988; Bates and Shah, 2017). Unfortunately, teaching of the tribe in Anthropology and Sociology has also been largely influenced by the same colonial literature and ethnographies. Important contributions have been made more recently in both disciplines (Bhaviskar, 1995, 2008; Shah, 2010; Sundar, 1997, 2016; Xaxa, 2003) and in History (Pati, 2011; Prasad, 2011) in arresting this misinterpretation of adivasi cultures. The teaching course will thereby probe the possibilities of internalizing colonial constructions and explore the process of constructing a people's perspective. It will take into account that colonial constructions are not completely new and do have the element of the local incorporated with its bias'. The questions to ask include, how does one construct an indigenous perspective? Does a constitutional category imply a homogenous group? If not, how is the category valid, what commonality holds the category together? To what extent is the common history of exclusion relevant? Exclusion: how and from what? In working through these questions, we want to explore the possibilities of social inclusion and why it has remained an unfulfilled challenge. In the past (both colonial and post colonial), attempts of adivasi inclusion have failed to arrest their 'alienation from Indian society and

polity' as the focus has been on the legal dimension of scheduling and economic backwardness (Oommen, 2014: 80-96). Social policy for adivasi inclusion has not given due attention to parameters of ecology and food (livelihood) and the relationship of the two inscribed in adivasi religion that form important identity markers.

By putting together readings for the above questions, a collaborative discussion based teaching programme with course syllabi will be framed that instructs and guides the methodology for research on this topic, to be initiated within the timeframe of this programme.

Project Objectives:

- a) Reflection on colonial knowledge policies and epistemologies within the discipline, especially regarding research, representation and teaching.
- b) Development of new forms of teaching (inclusion of Global South perspectives, critical reflection of and following improvements in curricular and syllabi), sustainable forms of cooperation; cooperative reflection on concepts and theories in presentation techniques (museum) and research.
- c) Development of a theoretical foundation for a decolonial approach when dealing with the 'cultural other'
- d) Re-thinking the colonial legacies of the university (structure, forms of learning, knowledge formation) in South Asia and Germany respectively, but especially in regard to the processes of creating academic/scientific knowledge about South Asia.
- e) Gain an insight into teaching and research topics in the Global South/Global North, get firsthand experience on South Asia.
- f) Develop through joint teaching and dialogue new teaching formats and contents that adhere to a decolonial approach.
- g) Develop jointly a perspective on decolonial research practices regarding methodological and theoretical objectives.

Brief Statement about long-term Impact:

The programme will provide an opportunity in establishing a long-term perspective of cooperative teaching and supervision. We, the PIs from Pondicherry University and Tuebingen university wish to take this opportunity to facilitate an interdisciplinary collaboration through the participation of other disciplines in social sciences from our respective universities. In this interdisciplinary social science background, we intend to develop joint teaching and research training through the inclusion of Global South perspectives and critical reflection of Eurocentric knowledge productions.

Activity Focus und Strategy:

The proposed program consists of work meetings, joint teaching in class and through summerschools, joint research and workshops. The challenge is to develop a decolonial approach and teaching program together, under active consideration of the expertise of the external partners.

- **1.** The inaugural meeting will clarify expectations and bring together proposals and a working plan.
- 2. The teaching will be done in a way that the external partners collaborate in the already running seminars which will have a topic on general decolonization theories, museum/material culture, social categories and their impact. Here the program will enable us to develop a jointly international perspective and new teaching tools and content, esp. with participation of students and project partners.
- **3.** The summer/winter-schools are designed to focus on the two topics and to on the one hand teach about the developments in the area of decolonization and on the other hand to engage with the fields on a practical basis. For the summerschool in Tübingen this includes the visit of ethnographic museums (Stuttgart, Berlin) with guided tours and discussions with the staff.
- **4.** The workshops will bring together the project partners and external partners as well as academics from other institutions to discuss the program objectives in a wider scale and to enable theoretical discussions and consequently also to develop publications and guidelines.
- 5. The joint research is supposed to bring together German and Indian academics and to conduct research focusing on the two topics, in close cooperation with the external partners. The underlying question what are the colonial ideologies and categories which structure and shape anthropology's research questions, methods and results/representations will be the guiding theme to reconsider methodological and ethical considerations of anthropological research in India, and to further ask how different forms of knowledge production could look like. The role of the external partners is very important here, because they bring in academic expertise but they also add voices from the field and help us to gain insights into the lived effects of colonial categories, e.g. when it comes to political/social classifications and the related subjectivities and agency of tribal/scheduled groups.
- **6.** The final work meeting shall process and evaluate the results of these interwoven activities and finale the publication plan.

Roles, expertise and activities of program partners

The PIs (Alex/Mummidi) will coordinate program and manage the group and workflow. They have established a close working relationship over the last 4 years through joint workshops (2017/18) and through a 3-month DAAD teaching fellowship of Prof. Mummidi in Tübingen in 2019. The topics chosen represent their expertise and field of research, Alex has conducted a 2-year project on the 'Discomforting Heritage' of the German ethnographic museums in cooperation with the Lindenmuseum Stuttgart. Mummidi has worked on *adivasis* and issues of inclusion and exclusion for the last 6 years.

The project partners at Tübingen university contribute to the program with a focus on museum sciences (Prof. Thiemeyer/ Historical and Cultural Anthropology), methodology (Prof.

Nieswand/Sociology) and South Asia anthropology (Prof. Polit). The role of the university project partners entails active cooperation in the summerschool, the teaching exchanges, the workshops, the planned publications and the development of new decolonial approaches to teaching and research. The concrete work division re. research will be finalized after the first work meeting.

The project partners from Pondicherry University complement the expertise in Tübingen with a focus on Tribal Folklore of South Asia (Prof. Chellaperumal/Social Anthropology) and *adivasis* (Prof. Mohanty/Sociology).

External Partners:

Our partners will take part in the workshops, summer/winterschools and accompany the teaching and research activities. They will enable the project participants to work on the two topics with external expertise and to include voices and opinions from the field of practice.

Sub: Report on the CV Raman International Research Fellowship for African Researchers

Ms Henna Helvina Neerunjun, from the Mahatma Gandhi Institute in Mauritius, has been a Visiting Fellow under the CV Raman International Fellowship for African Researchers in the Department of Coastal Disaster Management, Pondicherry University, Port Blair Campus from 22nd January 2024 to 29th March 2024 under the guidance of Professor (Dr.) S. Balaji.

During the first few weeks following her arrival to Port Blair, Ms Neerunjun has been working on coastal vulnerability assessment of Corbyn's Beach in South Andaman using the Analytical Hierarchy Process (AHP) which is a Multi-Criteria Decision-Making approach. This technique employs a set of parameters such as Geomorphology, Geology, Slope, Significant Max Wave Height, Tidal Range and Mean Sea Level Rise to assess coastal vulnerability to natural hazards. As each parameter receives its own importance weight, this method enables a pairwise comparison of the parameters and the parameter with the greatest impact on vulnerability along this stretch of the coastline can be identified. Her daily tasks consisted of learning this method of analysis for assessing coastal vulnerability through past theses and substantial reading of academic materials so that she is able to make use of the knowledge and skills gained to formulate and conduct new research on this subject using the AHP technique in any given study area.

Ms Neerunjun also had hands-on experience in total station surveying. She learned the basic components of the total station instrument and its function. This instrument is used for topographic surveys and was used to measure the slope elevation above sea level in the coastal vulnerability assessment at Corbyn's Cove beach. Demonstrations were given on how to set up the Total Station and explanations were provided on the importance of accurate levelling and centering. Measurement error and correction methods were also discussed. Practical sessions followed to familiarise with the operation of the Total Station instrument.

Ms Neerunjun then started to follow theoretical and practical sessions on Geographic Information System (GIS) in the Departmental lab to gain hands-on experience with the Arc GIS software which is a powerful tool for mapping purposes. This exercise aimed at equipping her with some of the skills required to map vulnerability or any other aspect of disaster management. The GIS tool was also used in the coastal vulnerability assessment of Corbyn's Cove Beach to map the geology of the area to show alluvial soil, flush sediments, deposits, rocks, pebbles, soils and the geomorphological features to depict the physical features and natural landforms of the area, for e.g., sandy beaches, cliffs and rocky shores. During her stay, Ms Neerunjun also attended an online course on Basics of QGIS from Monday 18th March 2024 to Friday 22nd March 2024 to consolidate her mapping capabilities. This Course was offered by the Centre for e-learning, Kerala Agricultural University. Online lectures introduced the theoretical aspects on operating the QGis software and handling geospatial data. Practical sessions consisted of navigating on the QGIS interface, manipulating spatial data and creating maps as visual outputs. The Course provided access to online datasets and localised sample maps were created during the training. It also tackled the different options for customising the presentation of maps using a variety of symbology choices such as the categorised and graduated styles.

During the tenure of her Fellowship, Ms Neerunjun has also been carrying out intensive literature review in the field of disaster management. She has been working on a proposal to assess coastal vulnerability and investigate the impact of shoreline changes on populations and ecosystems in one study area in her home country using the AHP technique. She has been comparing and contrasting different geospatial tools to improve early warning systems. Taking into consideration the mapping techniques she learnt, she has also been working on the revision of her paper entitled "Community-Based Strategies for Disaster Preparedness in Mauritius" which was published online on Friday 15th March 2024 by the Journal of Advanced and Applied Natural Sciences. This paper used mapping techniques to show the distribution of people-centred preparedness activities to disasters which have been carried out up to 2020 in Mauritius. As she is now equipped with new methods of analysis, she recently started working on another paper entitled "Archival Explorations of Environmental Hazards and Human Adaptation to Disasters in Mauritius". There are also emerging opportunities to submit proposals for funded projects in her home country, subject to data availability, to study coastal vulnerability or any other aspect of disaster management, she deems essential for her country using the relevant scientific techniques she learnt during her stay in Port Blair.
