

Faculty Development Programme on Psycho-Social Care in Disaster Management

06th - 10th November, 2023



BACKGROUND

India is vulnerable to a variety of natural and manmade disasters. Disaster knows no boundaries and impacts everyone. Its impact includes the vast destruction of infrastructure, leaving people distressed with shaken inner strength. This impact, at times, changes the behavioral pattern of the affected and is very difficult to visualize. This largely depends on the degree of the dent created by the neighborhood and trained professionals. Often, such behavioral changes are mistaken for mental malfunctions. This thinking adds to the seclusion of an already distressed person.

Along with relief, rehabilitation, and care of physical health and injuries, psycho-social and mental health issues are also essential and must be prioritized. Psycho-social support in the context of disasters refers to comprehensive interventions that address a wide range of psycho-social problems arising in the aftermath of a disaster. Psycho-social support comprises general interventions related to the larger issues of relief work needs, social relationships, and harmony to promote or protect the psycho-social wellbeing of the survivors. Mental health services comprise interventions to prevent or treat psychological symptoms or disorders. These interventions help individuals, families, and groups restore social cohesion and infrastructure while maintaining independence and dignity

The experience of disasters that have impacted various regions of India has revealed that Psycho-Social Support and Mental Health Services (PSSMHS) need to be planned ahead of disasters to be executed in a coordinated and integrated manner during disasters.

Psycho-social support for disaster-affected communities needs to be provided on a long-term basis. Appropriate and timely interventions will determine the victims' adjustments to various lifestyle changes caused by the disaster

The interventions must be community-based and culturally sensitive, considering the needs of vulnerable groups like women, children, the elderly, the disabled, etc. Such support can relieve the psychological distress of the affected people to a significant extent.

PSYCHO-SOCIAL SUPPORT

Psycho-social support in the context of disasters refers to comprehensive interventions that address a wide range of psychosocial and mental health problems arising in the aftermath of disasters. These interventions help individuals, families, and groups build human capacities, restore social cohesion and infrastructure, and maintain their independence, dignity, and cultural integrity. Psycho-social support helps in reducing the level of actual and perceived stress and in preventing adverse psychological and social consequences amongst disaster-affected communities.

India, due to its unique geo-climatic conditions, has been experiencing natural disasters like earthquakes, tsunamis, cyclones, floods, droughts and landslides. The country is equally vulnerable to man-made disasters like chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear emergencies. Disasters, whether natural or man-made, cause enormous devastation and human suffering to the community. These disasters usually leave a trail of human agony, including loss of human life and injuries, Emotional trauma, and loss of livestock, property and livelihood, resulting in long-term psychosocial and mental healthproblems. Apart from logistic and material help, the affected community requires Psycho-Social Support.

Importance of Psycho-Social care in Disaster management

For a considerable amount of time, the direction of disaster management efforts was focused on the physical impact of the disaster. Only after international human rights agencies brought awareness did psycho-social care in disaster management become part of rescue and rehabilitation manuals. Disaster's psychological impact is considered a forte of trained psychologists. But very few need and can access these services based on severe cases like PTSD. The second objective of the workshop is to make participants aware of the relevance of psychosocial care in disaster management.

Psycho-social Care with Women

Disasters generally lead to migration, mass displacement, the spread of epidemics, and issues of social security, etc. Women are more susceptible to the impact of disaster management due to already existing issues pertaining to them. The third objective of the workshop will include practical difficulties in psycho-social support for women in disaster-affected regions. It focuses on an intersectionality approach, which emphasizes layers of identity. Social, economic, and political vulnerabilities of women and inferior genders worsen with the advent of disaster.

Psycho-social Care with Children

Children lack the social and language skills to express their agony and difficulties. It becomes more severe in terms of psychological impact. Psycho-social care with children in disaster management areas includes several practical difficulties. Losing a loved one/family member/parent in a severe disaster also leads to generational traumas.

Not providing adequate psycho-social care for children suffering in case of disaster will lead to significant life challenges for them in the future. The workshop will inculcate orientation with experts in child psycho-social care.

Psycho-social care with marginalized / vulnerable populations: intersectionality, accessibility, rehabilitation.

The impact of disaster experienced by communities differs across their standing in the social, political, and economic ladder of society.

Navigating through rural and urban populations:

Community participation is more in the rural region due to its size and social connectivity. While people in urban spaces are more vulnerable to mental health issues due to hectic lifestyles, lack of socialization, alienation due to the nuclear nature of families, etc., interms of psycho-social care, these elements play an essential role in the approach to psycho-social supportcaregiver.

Role of social worker/Strength Perspective:

Social worker plays a multifold role in disaster management. The workshop will help social work educators, practitioners, and learners understand their role in these situations. Psycho-social care is an interdisciplinary approach, so it is essential for social workers. Very few social work educators are trained in Psycho-Social Care in Disaster Management. So this workshop will be more beneficial to the Social Work Educators.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The key target audience for this programme will be faculties from social science background and social work practitioners from Southern India. Preference will be given to social work educators. A maximum of 40 participants will be enrolled for the Five (5) days of TOT on Psycho-social support and care.

AIM OF TRAINING

Aim of this training programme is to build the capacity among the Social Work Educators and practitioners on basic concepts of disaster risk management and strengthening the mechanism for effective psychosocial care in disaster management.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To explain the basic concepts of Disaster Management
- 2. To understand varied needs of the survivors of disasters
- 3. To reflect upon the need for psycho-social care indisaster related work
- 4. To develop an understanding of how people react in stressful situations
- 5. To understand varied needs of the survivors of disasters
- 6. To develop an understanding of holistic care giving approach
- 7. To understand the role psycho-social care givers need to play
- 8. To internalize techniques of psycho-social care giving while working with children
- 9. To develop an understanding of needs of women in disasters and understand the role of women in disaster
- 10. To understand the importance of self-care and gain knowledge about skills on taking care of self while working in stressful situations.

LEARNING METHODS

The training will be conducted in English as well as vernacular language. The methodology is participatory in nature and will employ interpersonal communication techniques to make the training more interactive, practical with hands on experiences. Various participatory teaching and learning methods like Role play, Group Discussion, Videos, Case Studies and Games will be used to cover each training module.

TRAINING DURATION

This training programme is scheduled for 5 days in residential mode with six training modules. Each module has three to four lessons to meet the objectives of the training. This programme will be conducted in collaboration with ATIs, Central and State universities.

COURSE FEE ACCOMMODATION, AND OTHER ARRANGEMENTS

There is no course fee for the programme. Boarding and lodging is to be provided to the outstation participants during the period of the training programme. No TA/DA shall be paid to the participants.

EVALUATION

At the end of the programme, the participants will be provided with feedback form in a NIDM portal. Feedback form is mandatory for all the participants to be filled.







26.09.2023: 17.30-18.30hrs Online Lecture Series Tripura in the Trika system and in the Sarvamnaya Tantric Tradition

Dr. Sthaneshwar Timalsina, Department of Religious Studies, San Diego State University, California, USA



Sthaneshwar Timalsina obtained his Master's degree in 1991 from Sampurnananda University in Varanasi, India, and taught for several years at Nepal Sanskrit University, Kathmandu. He completed his PhD from Martin Luther University in Halle, Germany (2005) with a focus on the history of the philosophy of Advaita. His dissertation is published under the title, Seeing and Appearance (Shaker Verlag, 2006). Before joining San Diego State University in 2005, Timalsina taught at the University of California, Santa Barbara, and Washington University in St. Louis. His areas of research include classical Hindu, Buddhist, and Jain literature and philosophies with a specific focus on

consciousness studies. His book, Consciousness in Indian Philosophy (Routledge, 2008) is a comparative study of Advaita and Buddhist understandings of the self and consciousness. Timalsina also works in the area of Tantric studies and his recent publications, Tantric Visual Culture: A Cognitive Approach (Routledge, 2015), and Language of Images: Visualization and Meaning in Tantras (Peter Lang, 2015), explore the cognitive and cultural domains of Tantric visualization. Timalsina has published over forty articles, book chapters, and review essays on religion, culture, literature, aesthetics, and philosophy. Timalsina teaches courses on Hindu, Buddhist, and Jain religious, philosophical, and literary traditions, and his teaching interests include 'Religion and Science' as well as 'Yoga Philosophy and Practice.' His current areas of research include theories of mind, with a particular focus on the cognitive aspects of recognition, memory, imagination, and emotion. He is currently working as a Professor in Religions and Philosophies of India, San Deigo State University, California, USA.

Distinguished Lecture on The Bāla Tantras: Origins, State of Scholarship and Influence

Dr. Michael Slouber

Professor, Digital Humanities; South and Southeast Asian Studies; Religion & Culture, Western Washington University, Washington, USA

The Bāla Tantras are a little-known class of Tantric scriptures that are found in archives all over India. They are concerned with matters of fertility, healthy pregnancy, and protection of newborns and children from demonic attack. These texts flourished during the early Tantric era, from approximately 500 CE to 1,000 CE. The talk will review pre-Tantric references to similar subject matter, mainly from Āyurveda and the epics, and try to determine how these were adapted into the Tantras themselves. Some highlights from my new work editing and translating Kriyakālaguņottara will be shared. I will also look at various post-Tantric forms that the Bāla Tantras take and try to determine lines of influence between them.

Michael Slouber is a specialist in early medieval religions of India, and teaches a variety of courses in South Asian Studies and Religious Studies. Slouber is trained in the classical languages of India—Sanskrit, Pali, and Prakrit—at UC Berkeley. His research has focused on the history of medicine, Tantra, and studies of lesser-known goddess traditions. He is the author of Early Tantric Medicine: Snakebite, Mantras, and Healing in the Gāruḍa Tantras (OUP, 2016), and editor of A Garland of Forgotten Goddesses: Tales of the Feminine Divine from India and Beyond (UC Press, 2021) besides a number of articles, book chapters, and translations. His current project is on spirit possession and exorcism in early Tantric medical manuscripts.





The community-based student peer educators' sentiments for a healthy Puducherry echo the objectives of the project "Towards a Drug Free Puducherry District" – a community-based project jointly undertaken by the Department of Social Work, Pondicherry University and Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE), Government of India under Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan, Launched on 6th April 2022, over a period of 12 months, the project sensitized faculty and students from higher educational institutions in Puducherry against substance abuse and alcoholism in Puducherry District. As part of the project, students from 10 higher educational institutions in Puducherry were trained as peer educators to mobilize women, youth, and at-risk groups in local communities to address the substance use-related issues faced by community members and to aid them in accessing psychosocial support services.

The villages of Periyakalapet, Solainagar, Keezhparikalpattu, Kottaimedu, Melthirukanchi, Sivaranthagam, and Kezhoor were selected for peer-led interventions in this phase of the project. Between December 2022 and April 2023, the students organized a series of activities in these communities such as awareness programmes, focus-group discussions with women, youth and self-help group (SHG) members, health awareness sessions, sports and rangoli competitions, and household KAP (knowledge, attitude, and practice) surveys.

The student peer-educators were felicitated by Prof. Gurmeet Singh, Hon. Vice-Chancellor of Pondicherry University and Prof. B.B. Mohanty, Dean, School of Social Sciences and International Studies, Pondicherry University, Prof. R. Nalini, Principal Investigator provided a brief summary of the project's major achievements. Professor Gurmeet Singh, Hon. Vice-Chancellor, Pondicherry University delivered the presidential address and tabled the project report for the period April 2022-March 2023. Felicitations were offered by Professor B. B. Mohanty and Dr. K. Anbu, Head (i/c) Department of Social Work, Pondicherry University.

The dignitaries distributed the certificates and medals to the student peer educators in recognition of their work and achievements in their communities. Dr. Iftekhar Alam, Assistant Professor and Co-Principal Investigator offered the vote of thanks. The felicitation programme was organized to recognize and commend the potential of youth in Puducherry under the Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan campaign towards reducing the demand for drugs, especially among children and youth for the creation of a healthy and youthful Puducherry.





BACKGROUND

The interventions must be community-based and culturally sensitive, considering the needs of vulnerable groups like women, children, the elderly, the disabled, etc. Such support can relieve the psychological distress of the affected people to a significant extent

PSYCHO-SOCIAL SUPPORT

Psycho-social support in the context of disasters refers to comprehensive interventions that address a wide range of psychosocial and mental health problems arising in the aftermath of disasters. These interventions help individuals, families, and groups build human capacities, restore social cohesion and infrastructure, and maintain their independence, dignity, and cultural integrity Psycho-social support helps in reducing the level of actual and perceived stress and in preventing adverse psychological and social consequences amongst disaster-affected communities.

India, due to its unique geo-climatic conditions, has been experiencing natural disasters like earthquakes, tsunamis, cyclones, floods, droughts and landslides. The country is equally vulnerable to man-made disasters like chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear emergencies. Disasters, whether natural or man-made, cause enormous devastation and human suffering to the community. These disasters usually leave a trail of human agony including loss of human life and injuries. Emotional trauma, and loss of livestock, property and livelihood, resulting in long-term psychosocial and mental healthproblems. Apart from logistic and material help, the affected community requires Psycho-Social Support.

Importance of Psycho-Social care in Disaster management

For a considerable amount of time, the direction of disaster management efforts was focused on the physical impact of the disaster. Only after international human rights agencies brought awareness did psycho-social care in disaster management become part of rescue and rehabilitation manuals. Disaster's psychological impact is considered a forte of trained psychologists. But very few need and can access these services based on severe cases like PTSD. The second objective of the workshop is to make participants aware of the relevance of psycho-

Psycho-social Care with Women

Disasters generally lead to migration, mass displacement, the spread of epidemics, and issues of social security, etc. Women are more susceptible to the impact of disaster management due to already existing issues pertaining to them The third objective of the workshop will include practical difficulties in psycho-social support for women in disaster-affected regions. It focuses on an intersectionality approach, which emphasizes layers of identity. Social, economic, and political vulnerabilities of women and inferior genders worsen with the advent of disaster.

Psycho-social Care with Children

Children lack the social and language skills to express their agony and difficulties. It becomes more severe in terms of psychological impact. Psycho-occial care with children in disaster management areas includes several practical difficulties. Losing a loved one/family member/parent in a severe disaster also leads to generational traumas

Not providing adequate psycho-social care for children suffering in case of disaster will lead to significant life challenges for them in the future. The workshop will inculcate orientation with experts in child psycho-social care.

Psycho-social care with marginalized / vulnerable populations: intersectionality, accessibility, rehabilitation.

The impact of disaster experienced by con differs across their standing in the social, political, and economic ladder of society.

Navigating through rural and urban populations:

Community participation is more in the rural region due to its size and social connectivity. While people in urban spaces are more vulnerable to mental health issues due to hectic lifestyles, lack of socialization, ation due to the nuclear nature of families, etc., interms of psycho-social care, these elements play an essential role in the approach to psycho-social support caregiver

Role of social worker/ Strength Perspective:

Social worker plays a multifold role in dismanagement. The workshop will help social work educators, practitioners, and learners understand their role in these situations. Psycho-social care is an interdisciplinary approach, so it is essential for social workers. Very few social work educators are trained mPsycho-Social Care in Disaster Management. So this workshop will be more beneficial to the Social

Abstract: Surface and interface functionalization has been considered as an effective method to time the electronic properties of 2D materials. Following the advancement of graphene, many methods have been developed to precisely time the properties for its practical applications. We will be discussing the functionalization approaches such as surface modification and intercalation that have been employed to time the physical properties of graphene and transition metal dichalcogenides. Surface functionalization and the impact on the electronic properties have been extensively characterized by techniques such as scanning timelling microscopy (STM) and angle resolved ultraviolet photoelectron spectroscopy (ARPES). In the later part of the talk, we will also be seeing that how covalent functionalization is an equally effective method to time the optoelectronic properties of other 2D in alerials such as transition metal dichalcogenides. The visualization of grafted in olecules on the surface and their overall impact on the (opto)electronic properties of TMDs will be discussed by means of STM, Raman spectroscopy and PL studies. Self-intercalation of metal atoms in TMDs (inform of volume defects) can significantly impact the exotic phases that occurs in TMDs at low temperatures. We have studied the influence of surface defects on the long-range ordering of novel charge density phase of TiSe₂ by means of STM and STS, a glin pse of which will be presented in this talk.







A seminar hosted by the Department of English of Pondicherry University put the spotlight on the contributions of regional literary traditions to Indian Intellectual systems.

The two-day national seminar was held as part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahorsav to mark the 75th year of India's Independence, in collaboration with the Indian Council of Social Science Research, New Delhi (Ministry of Education).

Delivering the key-note address, T. V. Kartimari, Vice-Chancellor, Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh, emphasised the relevance of the seminar's theme and explained the need to include Indian knowledge systems in the curricula of schools and colleges India's rich cultural aciditions and literary works were repositories of knowledge ranging from classical philosophy to folk music, he said.

students to learn about India's vibrant culture. Seminars of this kind were viable solutions to rekindle students' interest in this area and promote its inclusion in mainstream education, he said.



The inaugural session was attended by various dignitaries including, Ambassador Rudrendra Tandon, Additional Secretary, Ministry of External Affairs, Professor Gurmeet Singh, Vice Chancellor, Pondicherry University, Professor V. Geethalakshmi, Vice Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Agriculture University, Coimbatore, Dr Mamata Pradhan, IFPRI, Professor S.K. Mohanty and Dr Pankhuri Gaur, RIS.

Dr Pradhan, in her welcome remarks, emphasised on the collaborative research, capacity partnership and policy engagement as the main pillar for this capacity building programme. The inaugural address by Prof. Geethalakshmi raised the issue of climate change in agriculture sector and how trade can help in adopting climate-smart agriculture.

Ambassador Tandon highlighted the importance of trade facilitation and investment to boost the agriculture trade in the BIMSTEC region. He added, "BIMSTEC is a read-made machinery for policy action at the regional level". Prof. Gurmeet Singh expressed his views on the global agriculture scenario and India's role in the world economy through G20.

Prof. S.K. Mohanty, RIS, New Delhi, in his special remarks, emphasized that the rise of middle-income groups in several developing countries is posing the issue of nutritional challenges, in addition to the challenges of livelihood security amidst trade surplus. The dignitaries also released a book on "BIMSTEC: Mapping Sub-Regionalism in Asia". The inaugural session concluded with vote of thanks by Dr Pankhuri Gaur, RIS.






