NOVEL CORONA VIRUS (COVID - 19) GENERAL ADVISORY FOR PUBLIC

The Novel Corona Virus is a Contagious Virus that Causes respiratory infection, can transfer from human to human.

SYMPTOMS :

- * Fever
- * Difficulty in Breathing
- * Cough
- * Tightness of Chest
- * Running Nose
- * Head Ache
- * Feeling of being Unwell
- * Pneumonia

INCUBATION PERIOD : 14 days.

MODE OF TRANSMISSION:

Corona Virus (COVID - 19) most commonly spreads from an infected person to other through:

- * The air by Coughing and Sneezing.
- * Close Personal contact, such as touching or Shaking hand.
- * Touching an object or surface with the Virus on it then touching your mouth, nose or eyes before washing your hands.

HOW TO REDUCE RISK OF CORONA VIRUS INFECTION (COVID-19) :

- * Clean hands with soap and water or alcohol based hand rub.
- * Cover nose and mouth when Coughing & Sneezing with tissue paper or flexed elbow.
- * Avoid close contact with anyone with cold or flu like symptoms.
- * Isolation of Symptomatic patients for atleast 14 days.

DO's:

- * Cover your nose and mouth with disposable tissue paper or handkerchief while Coughing or Sneezing.
- * Frequently wash your hands with soap and water
- * Avoid Crowded places.
- * Person Suffering from influenza like illness must limit contact with others and rest in a separate room (14 days).
- * Stay more than one arm's length distance from person sick with flu.
- * Take adequate rest and sleep.
- * Drink plenty of water / liquids and eat nutritious food.
- * Person suspected with influenza like illness must consult doctor immediately.
- * Person having, fever, cough and running nose must wear face mask.

DON'Ts:

- * Touching eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands.
- * Hugging, Kissing and Shaking Hands while greeting.
- * Spitting in Public Places.
- * Taking Medicines without Consulting Doctor.
- * Disposal of used napkin or tissue paper in open areas.
- * Touching surfaces usually used by Public (Railing, door gates, etc.,)
- * Unnecessary testing for illness.

Creating Awareness and Cultural Sensitivity

**A Two day Workshop co-organised by Centre
for Women's Studies, Pondicherry University and SAFIC**

Description

Menstruation is a natural biological process that women undergo during a major period of their lives. Because of its connection with fertility and pregnancy, menstruation is closely linked with womanhood suggesting some of the fundamental differences between men and women at many levels including physical, emotional and psychological. It is no wonder then that over the ages, menstruation and related practices have figured significantly in the evolving perceptions of different societies and cultures across the world toward women, man-woman relationships, and the place and role of women in society as a whole.

The proposed two day workshop is designed to address several of the issues related to menstrual health and hygiene. This aims to promote a deeper awareness and cultivate a greater cultural sensitivity toward various issues related to menstruation, and menstrual health and hygiene practices. Some of the workshop content will directly address various practical topics related to menstrual health and hygiene practices. These include:

- A deeper cultural and psychological understanding of menstruation
- Power of Womanhood
- A cross-cultural review of menstruation related beliefs, practices and customs
- Maintaining healthy lifestyle and dealing with menstrual irregularities
- Cleansing practices for body and mind through Yoga
- Using sustainable menstrual hygiene products

Learning Outcomes:

1. This workshop will help the learners move away from a superficial and sensationalist view toward the sensitive topic of menstruation and menstrual health, by encouraging open-minded conversations and through study of various aspects related to this topic.
2. This workshop will help prepare the learners become more informed, sensitive and open-minded about this important topic of menstruation and its connection with overall health and well-being of girls, women and ultimately the society itself.
3. This workshop will facilitate among the learners a deeper examination of some of their own biases and wrong assumptions resulting from either misinformation or misperception or both.
4. By facilitating greater awareness of menstrual health and hygiene and inculcating deeper cultural sensitivity toward it, this workshop can also become an important step toward preparing the young generations to take greater responsibility toward their role in creating a more conscious humanity.

Pondy LG inaugurates 'Pahirvoma'

Puducherry, May 31 (UNI) Lt. Governor Tamilisai Soundararajan on Monday launched the tele counselling service 'Pahirvoma' ,organized by the department of Social Works,Pondicherry University and the Directorate of Health and Family Welfare,Government of Puducherry to provide tele-counselling services for those affected by COVID 19, their families and those who are in need.

According to a University release,Pahirvoma is operational from 10 am to 8 pm on all seven days of the week. The tele counsellors are full time research scholars from the Department of Social Work, Pondicherry University pursuing their doctoral degree in Social Work. Of the 28 full time scholars almost 90 per cent draw fellowships from UGC, ICMR and similar national funding agencies. Apart from attending to calls requiring counselling service, they shall also call COVID patients in home isolation in need of psychological support.

Between 8 pm and 10 am, the caller shall have an option to contact the personnel in 104 who shall inform the tele counsellors the next day for necessary action. The Department of Social Work, Pondicherry University has formed a Core Committee for this purpose comprising all its six faculty members.

Solar man's campaign for energy security

Solanki's 'Energy Swaraj Yatra' aims at driving 100% adoption of solar energy

A solar bus that is pivoting a nation-wide campaign to gain energy security by tapping sunlight, rolled into Pondicherry University to a rousing reception recently.

The solar bus symbolises the 'Energy Swaraj Yatra', a vehicular renewable energy campaign led by Chetan Singh Solanki, a professor at IIT Bombay, who goes by the epithet 'Solar Man of India'.

The Energy Swaraj Yatra led by Mr. Solanki was given a reception by the team from the Department of Green Energy Technology (DGET), Madanjeet School of Green Energy Technologies at the Pondicherry University as part of promoting the vision to promote energy harvesting, conservation and utilisation.

In the wake of serious and catastrophic climate change, the yatra is designed with the purpose to create a public movement towards 100% adoption of solar energy.

The vehicle had reached the campus after travelling for 500 days on road. Mr. Solanki's yatra bus, a sort of home on wheels, is equipped with 5.2 kW solar

panels and 6kWh of battery storage, and a 3kVa inverter. It also houses facilities such as lights, cooler, stove and other appliances that run entirely on solar energy.

The vehicle, which set out from Mumbai in 2020, will be on the road for 11 years until 2030 to drive the campaign across the country.

During his visit to Pondicherry University, Mr. Solanki inaugurated a 'Meet the Giants' lecture series, hosted by the DGET.

In his lecture titled 'Energy, Climate change and I', Mr. Solanki noted that there was an imperative for change in energy usage and consumption pattern in the current energy scenario. The

reality is that 33 million kg of CO₂ is emitted per second and it keeps on increasing, he said.

'Switch to solar'

He advised the audience to switch to solar energy instead of depending on conventional energy resources. After 1950, global energy use has grown exponentially and 80-85% of it was contributed by fossil fuels. In fact, the planet is warmer by 1.1 degrees Celsius, compared to the pre-industrial era, calling for drastic measures to limit warming to, ideally, 1.5 degrees Celsius. "Once this threshold is crossed, the changes will be irreversible," he added.

Mr. Solanki advocated a three-step approach for switching fully to solar energy — 'avoid, minimise, generate'. This involved avoiding use of energy as much as possible even if it is solar energy, or at least minimising its use and generating energy locally.

Mr. Solanki pointed out that energy 'swaraj' was about distributed production. There are two important 'laws' that needed careful study.

In an ecosystem of finite resources, there could only be finite consumption. And, two, in an ecosystem of finite resources, there would have to be distributed production.

Earlier, Pondicherry University Vice-Chancellor Gurmeet Singh inaugurated the session and also felicitated Mr. Solanki. P. Elumalai, head of department and R. Prasanth, programme coordinator also spoke.

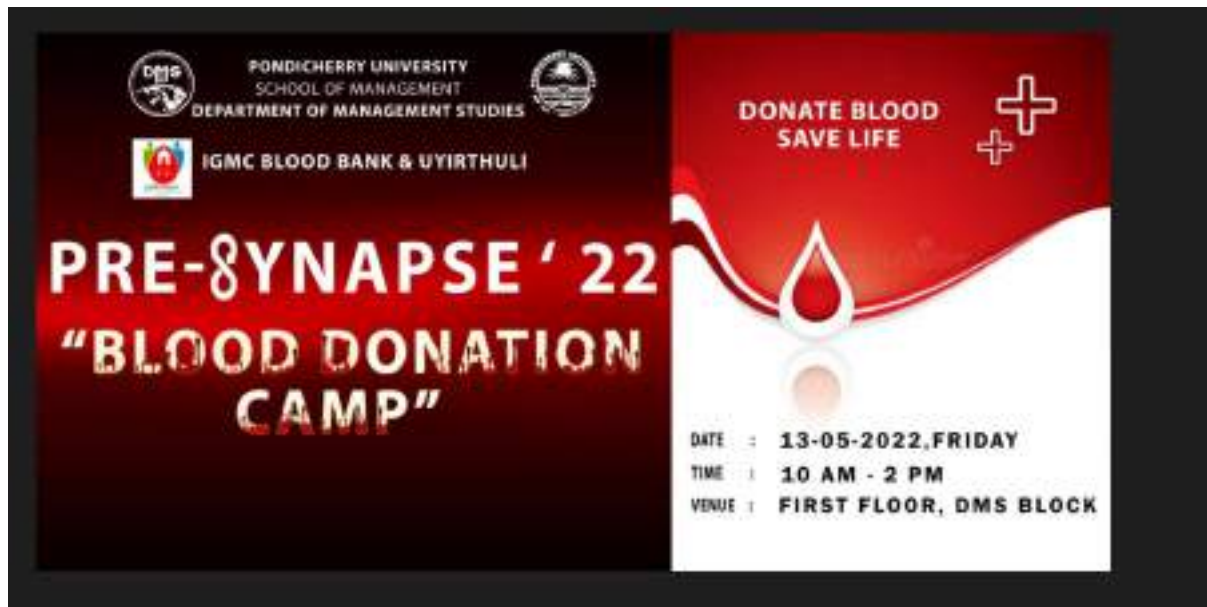
According to the University, Mr. Solanki is undertaking his mission while on unpaid leave from IIT Bombay. He is the brand ambassador of solar energy for the Madhya Pradesh Government and the founder of the Energy Swaraj Foundation.

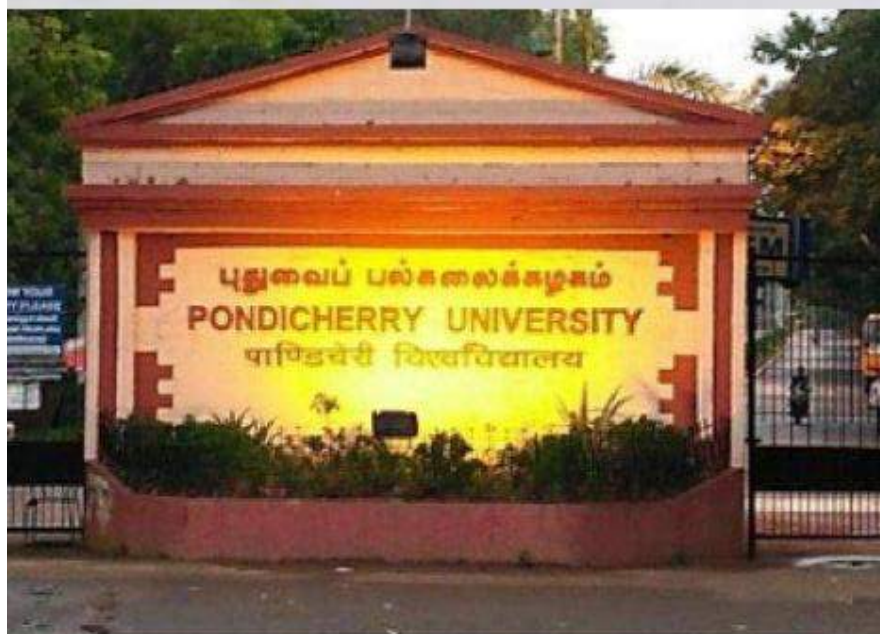


