Dear Prof. Tareen,

Kindly recall that we had a meeting with you on 7th November, 2008 to consider the XI Plan allocation based on the reports submitted by the XI Plan Visiting Committee.

2. Based on the priorities indicated by you and suggestions made in the meetings held in the UGC as well as the availability of funds from Govt. of India, UGC has approved the tentative XI Plan allocation, subject to availability of funds from Government of India, in respect of your University as under :

(Rs. in lakhs)

General Development Grant including Community College : and Rs.1400.00 lakhs for Karaikal Campus	Rs.12350.00
Merged Schemes : (details of allocation of each scheme is enclosed)	Rs. 462.50
Fellowship for doing M.Phil / Ph.D. :	Rs. 900.00

3. In addition to above, UGC has also allocated an amount of **Rs.9002.00** lakhs for implementation of OBC reservation in admission. Thus, total allocation would be **Rs. 22714.50 lakhs**. The grant already released by the UGC during XI Plan is a part of XI Plan allocation.

4. A new scheme called **Internal Quality Assurance Cell** has also been included in the merged schemes and an amount of Rs.5.00 lakhs has been allocated to each Central University. The guidelines of this scheme will be sent to you shortly.

5. The university may obtain the prior administrative approval of UGC for creation of any non-teaching posts if it required essentially and the teaching to non-teaching ratio is within the ratio of 1 : 1.5- 2.00 as prescribed by the Expenditure Reforms Commission. However, as per latest communication received from MHRD the teaching to non-teaching ratio recommended is 1 : 1.1. The creation of teaching posts should be based on the norms for ideal teacher-student ratio as prescribed by the various regulatory authorities.

6. It is for your kind information that the amount allocated under the head of Fellowship cannot be diverted / re-appropriated to any other head. The XI Plan allocation is subject to compliance of the Academic Reforms as already circulated by the UGC vide its D.O.No.F.1-2/2008 (XI Plan) dated 31st January,2008 (copy enclosed).



7. In addition to above, the following administrative reforms may also be implemented:-
- Implementation of the Govt. of India reservation policy of SC/ST sent in 2006
 - All statutory posts should be filled by appointment through Selection Committee as per UGC Regulations.
 - All vacant teaching posts should be filled up expeditiously.
 - Annual Accounts, Annual Reports and Quality Assessment Status Report should be submitted in time i.e. by 31st December every year to Govt. of India.
8. The release of grant will also be linked to academic and administrative reforms as well as compliance of various policies of Govt. of India rules as indicated above.
9. It has been observed that your university has awarded the higher pay scales to some category of non-teaching staff retrospectively. This is a very serious matter. You are, therefore, requested to take corrective measures immediately under the intimation of UGC and resolve the disparities in existing pay scales of non-teaching staff arising out of OTUM and implementation of Assured Career Progression Scheme as per UGC guidelines circulated to all Central Universities vide UGC letter No.F.6-7/97 (CU/JCRC) dated 13th March, 2006 failing which UGC would be constrained to reduce your XI Plan allocation.
10. You are also requested to utilize proportionate grant on half yearly basis. Any portion remain unutilized will be considered to be lapsed. UGC will also consider to allocate the unutilized grant of the university to other universities which are better performing and are also following the various academic reforms as well as implementation of various policies of Govt. of India. Therefore, the university is advised to utilize the grant fully.
11. You are, therefore, requested to re-work the priorities of University within the General Development Grant allocation as decided by the Commission and keeping in view the recommendation of the Visiting Committee. The revised proposal (item-wise and year-wise plan) in the prescribed format of UGC (copy enclosed) may be sent within 15 days in duplicate alongwith the soft copy within the ceiling conveyed to the University. After receipt of the item-wise allocation within the amount as decided by the Committee, the UGC will convey the final approval of XI Plan allocation to the University.

Dear Professor Tareen,

This is in continuation to this office letter No.F.24-9/2008(CU) dated 5th December, 2008 about the intimation of XI Plan allocation of your University. I am grateful to you for the cooperation extended for furnishing the information required by the UGC.

Based on the priorities indicated by you, as well as the availability of funds from Govt. of India, UGC has approved the final XI Plan allocation of **Rs.12350.00 lakhs** under General Development Grant. However, the release of grant would be subject to availability of funds received from Govt. of India.

The XI plan allocation under General Development Grant for your University along with the detailed breakup is given in the enclosed statement duly signed by the undersigned. A copy of the Visiting Committee Report has already been given to you in the meeting held in the UGC Office.

The UGC has already finalized the guidelines for the schemes to be operated in the XI Plan. These guidelines are posted on the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. I would request you to browse the UGC website regularly to keep yourself abreast of the latest XI Plan guidelines finalized by the UGC.

The University may follow the procedure for constructions of buildings strictly as prescribed in the UGC guidelines. The Building Committee should be constituted as per UGC guidelines and the constitution of the Committee should be intimated to UGC.

The University may follow strictly the Government of India/UGC's guidelines regarding implementation of the reservation policy [both vertical (for SCs, STs & OBCs) and horizontal (for persons with disability etc.)] in teaching and non-teaching posts.

The teaching posts as approved by the UGC in the existing departments may be filled up in a phased manner as per requirement of the University. The teaching posts for the new proposed departments may be filled up on the basis of intake of students admitted in the University. The requirement of non-teaching staff will be considered separately by the Committee constituted for this purpose and will be communicated to you shortly.

I hope the university must have also initiated the Academic Reforms as already circulated by the UGC vide its D.O.No.F.1-2/2008 (XI Plan) dated 31st January, 2008. It may also be ensured that the university has adopted the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree), Regulations, 2008.

In the end, I would request you to ensure that the utilization of the grants received by the university shall be submitted to the UGC in time to enable smooth management of funds and to avoid unnecessary audit objections.

The Government of India, MHRD vide letter No.F.3-2/2007-U.5 dated 27th May,2008 constituted an Empowered Committee in respect of each Central University to examine Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) prepared by the Central University concerned and to accord necessary clearance in the matter.

2. The Empowered Committee in its meeting held on 6th June,2008 in UGC office, after discussion with the representative of your University, has approved the tentative outlay for implementation of OBC Reservation as per the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006 as detailed below:-

Recurring Grant includes five years expenditure on salary of teachers, non-teaching posts and non-salary/other expenditure etc.

Non-Recurring Grant includes augmentation of infrastructural facilities like laboratories, IT infrastructure, library facilities, hospitals beds (for medical colleges), equipments, construction of additional academic buildings, classrooms, hostels, houses for faculty and non-faculty etc.

The Commission in its meeting held on 18th-19th June,2008 has approved the recommendations of Empowered Committee.

3. The abovementioned allocation is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions: -

- Teaching as also non-teaching positions on account of the proposed capacity expansion could be created by the Executive Council/Board of Management of the respective Universities provided the ratio for teaching and non-teaching posts after the proposed expansion would remain within the prescribed limit.
- In case the prescribed ratio for teaching and non-teaching posts do not permit creation of any more non-teaching posts, no non-teaching non-technical posts be created at this stage, while the genuine requirement of the Universities for such non-teaching technical positions as are considered to be essential for supporting teaching and research due to expansion programme will be

The above-mentioned approval is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- (i) University may fill up the teaching positions at the earliest and explore the possibility to allocate the vacant teaching positions in the new areas or where the requirement of teaching positions in a particular department is more needed.

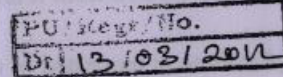
