Kindly recall that we had a meeting with you on 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2008 to consider the XI Plan allocation based on the reports submitted by the XI Plan Visiting Committee.

2. Based on the priorities indicated by you and suggestions made in the meetings held in the UGC as well as the availability of funds from Govt. of India, UGC has approved the tentative XI Plan allocation, subject to availability of funds from Government of India, in respect of your University as under:

- 3. In addition to above, UGC has also allocated an amount of Rs.9002.00 lakhs for implementation of OBC reservation in admission. Thus, total allocation would be Rs. 22714.50 lakhs. The grant already released by the UGC during XI Plan is a part of XI Plan allocation.
- 4. A new scheme called Internal Quality Assurance Cell has also been included in the merged schemes and an amount of Rs.5.00 lakhs has been allocated to each Central University. The guidelines of this scheme will be sent to you shortly.
- 5. The university may obtain the prior administrative approval of UGC for creation of any non-teaching posts if it required essentially and the teaching to non-teaching ratio is within the ratio of 1: 1.5- 2.00 as prescribed by the Expenditure Reforms Commission. However, as per latest communication received from MHRD the teaching to non-teaching ratio recommended is 1: 1.1. The creation of teaching posts should be based on the norms for ideal teacher-student ratio as prescribed by the various regulatory authorities.

6. It is for your kind information that the amount allocated under the head of Fellowship cannot be diverted / re-appropriated to any other head. The XI Plan allocation is subject to compliance of the Academic Reforms as already circulated by the UGC vide its D.O.No.F.1-2/2008 (XI Plan) dated 31<sup>st</sup> January,2008 (copy enclosed).

- 7. In addition to above, the following administrative reforms may also be implemented:-
  - Implementation of the Govt. of India reservation policy of SC/ST sent in 2006
  - All statutory posts should be filled by appointment through Selection Committee as per UGC Regulations.
  - All vacant teaching posts should be filled up expeditiously.
  - Annual Accounts, Annual Reports and Quality Assessment Status Report should be submitted in time i.e. by 31<sup>st</sup> December every year to Govt. of India.
- 8. The release of grant will also be linked to academic and administrative reforms as well as compliance of various policies of Govt. of India rules as indicated above.
- 9. It has been observed that your university has awarded the higher pay scales to some category of non-teaching staff retrospectively. This is a very serious matter. You are, therefore, requested to take corrective measures immediately under the intimation of UGC and resolve the disparities in existing pay scales of non-teaching staff arising out of OTUM and implementation of Assured Career Progression Scheme as per UGC guidelines circulated to all Central Universities vide UGC letter No.F.6-7/97 (CU/JCRC) dated 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2006 failing which UGC would be constrained to reduce your XI Plan allocation.
- 10. You are also requested to utilize proportionate grant on half yearly basis. Any portion remain unutilized will be considered to be lapsed. UGC will also consider to allocate the unutilized grant of the university to other universities which are better performing and are also following the various academic reforms as well as implementation of various policies of Govt. of India. Therefore, the university is advised to utilize the grant fully.
- 11. You are, therefore, requested to re-work the priorities of University within the General Development Grant allocation as decided by the Commission and keeping in view the recommendation of the Visiting Committee. The revised proposal (item-wise and year-wise plan) in the prescribed format of UGC (copy enclosed) may be sent within 15 days in duplicate alongwith the soft copy within the ceiling conveyed to the University. After receipt of the item-wise allocation within the amount as decided by the Committee, the UGC will convey the final approval of XI Plan allocation to the University.


