# The Recommendations of the NAAC for Quality Enhancement of the Institute has been discussed point wise:

 Additional Centers for conduct of entrance test may be created for student admission to Pondicherry University.

It was recommended that all the centres where entrance exams was conducted in May 2013 - 2014 are to be retained and additional centres may be opened depending on number of applications received.

2. Teaching and research programmes could be commenced in Genetics, Biodiversity, and Plant Sciences, in view of the current importance of these disciplines.

New programmes in the field of Genetics, Biodiversity and Plant Sciences has been proposed for study:

- 1. Stem Cell
- 2. Genetic Biology,
- 3. Animal Cell etc.,
- 3. Personality building courses may be created for all-round student development.
  - Dr. Rajeswari Seshadri, Associate Professor, Dept of Mathematics conducting Soft course/skill development programme in collaboration with IITs and the same may be streamlined and in the name of Institution to benefit other students as well.
- 4. Linkages between related disciplines and interdisciplinary work may be strengthened in both Teaching and Research.

It was noted that interdisciplinary research is conducted involving some of the departments such as Physics and Earth Sciences, Biotechnology and Earth Sciences and Earth Sciences and Chemistry. However, this needs to be further strengthened.

5. Open electives in subjects such as Biostatistics, Computer Modelling and Simulation, Statistical Methodology, and Drug Designing may be introduced.

Already introduced as Add-on courses in various departments for the benefit of students

6. Social Science students should be offered courses on major advances in the Sciences and vice versa.

A curriculum to be developed in the Science and Social Sciences faculties at very basic level. Such course in Science is to be offered as soft core course for Humanities and Social Sciences Students only and vice versa.

7. Teaching, learning and evaluation should lay proper emphasis on critical and creative thinking.

Under the CBCS due attention is paid on this aspect. Further strengthening needs additional innovation.

8. Non-teaching and technical staff strength may be augmented to cope with the University's expansion.

To be addressed – to prepare the database.

9. Video-conferencing facilities between the main campus and satellite campuses should be improved.

Video conferencing facilities are already established between the Main Campus and Karaikal Campus and recently Port Blair Campus also.

10. The Library should acquire latest scholarly editions of books and print versions of major journals.

The Librarian pointed out that due to non-availability of funds for the past 3 years books could not be purchased. If sufficient funds are made available by the UGC purchase of books will be taken up

11. An Ethics Committee for Research should be established

Each School will establish an ethical committee and these School Ethical Committee will come under one umbrella (i.e), University Institution Ethics Committee for which Director (Research) or Senior Most Dean will be the Chairperson of the Committee.

12. The University may consider providing an independent auditorium for the School of Performing Arts and establishing a Convention Centre.

In vacant space near to the School of Performing Arts building an Open Theatre / auditorium is to be constructed for practicing stage performance by students of School of Performing Arts.

13. NET/SET Centre may be established at the University.

Special Coaching Classes for NET/SLET/SET has been already established and University is conducting the UGC NET examination as per the direction of UGC.

14. There should be greater interaction of the University with the local community.

#### 3.2 Institutional Weaknesses:

 Independent career guidance and counseling cell may be strengthened to make the students more employable.

Each School should have the placement cell, a faculty of the School will be incharge of placement activities. A full time placement officer for the University will be appointed who will co-ordinate placement activities of all the Schools of Pondicherry University and affiliated colleges.

#### 3.3 Institutional Opportunities:

 Plant science research programmes may be established, making use of the huge and verdant campus Establishment of International Centre for Land Use and Bioresources (ICLUB) at Pondicherry University in collaboration with University of Basel is under process.
