This Agreement is made and entered into at Puducherry on this day of December 2021 between the Eligible Consumer Registrar, Pondicherry University having premises at R.V Nagar, Chinnakalapet, Puducherry -14 and Consumer No. 152 as the first party,

The Distribution Licensec The Superintending Engineer - Cum - HOD, Electricity Department, Puducherry, (hereinafter referred to as "The Licensee") and having its Registered Office at No.137, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Salai (Gingee Salai), Duppuypet, Puducherry-605001 as Second Party of this Agreement;

Whereas, the Eligible Consumer has applied to Licensee for approval of a Net Metering Arrangement under the provisions of the Joint Electricity Regulatory Commission (Solar PV Grid Interactive System based on Net Metering) Regulations, 2019 (herein after referred to as "the Net Metering Regulations") and sought its connectivity to the Licensee's Distribution Network.

And whereas, the Licensee has agreed to provide Network Connectivity to the Eligible Consumer for injection of electricity generated from its Solar Project of 2400 Kilowatt;

Both Parties hereby agree as follows:-

Eligibility:

The Solar Project meets the applicable norms for being integrated into the Distribution Network, and that the Eligible Consumer shall maintain the project accordingly for the duration of this Agreement.

Technical and Inter-connection Requirements: 2.

- The metering arrangement and the inter-connection of the Solar Project with the network of the Licensee shall be as per the provisions of the Net Metering Regulations and the technical standards and norms specified by the Central Electricity Authority for connectivity of distributed generation resources and for the installation and operation of meters.
- 2.2. The Eligible Consumer agrees, that he shall install, prior to connection of the Solar Project to the network of the Licensee, an isolation device (both automatic and in built within inverter and external manual relays); and the Licensee shall have access to it if required for the repair and maintenance of the Distribution Network.
- 2.3. The Licensee shall specify the interface/inter-connection point and metering point.

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The Eligible Consumer shall furnish all relevant data, such as voltage, frequency, circuit breaker, isolator position in his System, as and when required 2.4. by the Licensec.

3. Safety:

- The equipment connected to the Licensee's Distribution System shall be compliant with relevant International (IEEE/IEC) or India Standards (BIS), as the case may be, and the installation of electrical equipment shall comply with the requirements specified by the Central Electricity Authority regarding safety and electricity supply.
- The design, installation, maintenance and operation of the Solar Project shall be undertaken in a manner conducive to the safety of the Roof-top Solar PV 3.2. System as well as the Licensee's Network.
- If, at any time, the Licensee determines that the Eligible Consumer's Solar 3.3. Project is causing or may cause damage to and/or results in the Licensee's other Consumers or its assets, The Eligible Consumer shall disconnect the solar project from the distribution network upon direction from the Licensee, and shall undertake corrective measures at his own expense prior to re-connection.
- The Licensee shall not be responsible for any accident resulting in injury to 3.4. human beings and animals or damage to property that may occur due to back feeding from the Solar Project when the grid supply is off. The Licensee may disconnect the installation at any time in the event of such exigencies to present such accident.

Other Clearances and Approvals: 4.

The Eligible Consumer shall obtain any statutory approvals and clearance that may be required, such as from the Electrical Inspector or the Municipal or other authorities, before connecting the Solar Project to the distribution network.

Period of Agreement, and Termination:

This Agreement shall be for a period for 25 years from the date of effecting grid Connection i.e, 6.8.2021 but may be terminated prematurely

a) By mutual consent; or

b) By the Eligible Consumer, by giving 30 days' notice to the Licensee;

e) By the Licensee, by giving 30 days' notice, if the Eligible Consumer breaches any terms of this Agreement or the provisions of the Net

Metering Regulations and does not remedy such breach within 30 days, or such other reasonable period as may be provided, of receiving notice of such breach, or for any other valid reason communicated by the Licensee in writing.

6. Access and Disconnection:

- 6.1. The Eligible Consumer shall provide access to the Licensee to the metering equipment and disconnecting devices of Solar Project, both automatic and manual, by the Eligible Consumer.
- 6.2. If, in an emergent or outage situation, the Licensee cannot access the disconnecting devices of the Solar Project, both automatic and manual, it may disconnect power supply to the premises.
- 6.3. Upon termination of this Agreement under Clause 5, the Eligible Consumer shall disconnect the Solar Project forthwith from the Network of the Licensee.

7. Liabilities:

- 7.1. The Parties shall indemnify each other for damages or adverse effects of either Party's negligence or misconduct during the installation of the Solar Project, connectivity with the distribution network and operation of the System.
- 7.2. The Parties shall not be liable to each other for any loss of profits or revenues, business interruption losses, loss of contract or goodwill, or for indirect, consequential, incidental or special damages including, but not limited to, punitive or exemplary damages, whether any of these liabilities, losses or damages arise in contract, or otherwise.

8. Commercial Settlement:

- 8.1. The commercial settlements under this Agreement shall be in accordance with the Net Metering Regulations.
- 8.2. The Licensee shall not be liable to compensate the Eligible Consumer if his Solar Project is unable to inject surplus power generated into the Licensee's Network on account of failure of power supply in the grid/Network.
- 8.3. The existing metering System, if not in accordance with the Net Metering Regulations, shall be replaced by a bidirectional meter (whole current/CT operated), and a separate generation meter may be provided to

measure Solar power generation. The bi-directional meter (whole current/ CT operated) shall be 'consec's CT operated) shall be installed at the inter-connection point to the Licensee's Network for recording export and import of energy.

- The uni-directional and bi-directional meters shall be fixed in separate meter boxes in the same proximity.
- 8.5. The Licensee shall issue monthly electricity bill for the net metered energy on the scheduled date of meter reading. If the exported energy exceeds the imported energy, the Licensee shall show the net energy exported as credited Units of electricity as specified in the Net Metering Regulations, 2019. If the exported energy is less than the imported energy, the Eligible Consumer shall pay the Distribution License for the net energy imported at the prevailing tariff approved by the Commission for the Consumer category to which he belongs.

The Eligible Consumer shall bear all costs related to the setting up of the 9. Connection Costs: Solar Project excluding the Net Metering Arrangement cost beyond the Net Meter.

10. Dispute Resolution:

- 10.1. Any dispute arising under this Agreement shall be resolved promptly, in good faith and in an equitable manner by both the Parties.
- 10.2. Disputes pertaining to billing / payments and metering shall be referred to the Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum (CGRF) and then to the Ombudsman appointed under sub-section 6 of section 42 of the Act for settlement in case the same is not resolved at CGRF.



 Authorisation is accorded to M/s. Pondicherry University, Kalapet, Puducherry for generation, segregation, storage, collection and disposal of Bio-Medical waste as per the capacity given below:

1.	Yellow	Human Anatomical Waste, Soiledwaste, chemical solid and liquid waste and microbiology, biotechnology and other clinical laboratory waste	6.0
2.	Red	Contaminated waste (Recyclable)	2.0

4.	Blue	Glasswares, metallic body implants	0.5

- This authorisation is subject to the conditions stated below and to such other conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- Bio-Medical waste shall not be stored in the premises beyond 48 hours as per Rule 8(7).
- The authorised person shall submit an Annual Report to the prescribed authority in Form - IV by 30th June every year.
- The authorised person shall submit Report on Accident, if any, to the prescribed authority in Form - I.
- (a) The Bio-Medical waste should be collected in different colour bags as per the Schedule-I (See rules 3 (e), 4(b), 7(1), 7(2), 7(5), 7 (6) and 8(2)).
 (b) The Label for Bio-Medical Waste container / Bags should be maintained as per Schedule-III (See rule 8 (3) (5).
- 7. Pre-treat the laboratory waste, microbiological waste, blood samples and blood bags through disinfection or sterilisation on-site in the manner as prescribed by the World Health Organisation(WHO) or National AIDs Control Organisation (NACO) guidelines and then sent to the Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment Facility for final disposal.
- 8. Provide training to all its health care workers and others, involved in handling of bio medical waste at the time of induction and thereafter at least once every year and the details of training programmes conducted, number of personnel trained and number of personnel not undergone any training shall be provided in the Annual Report;
- Immunise all its health care workers and others, involved in handling of bio-medical waste for protection against diseases.
- Ensure segregation of liquid chemical waste at source and ensure pre-treatment or neutralisation prior to mixing with other effluent generated from health care facilities;

- Ensure treatment and disposal of liquid waste in accordance with the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (6 of 1974);
- 12. Conduct health check up at the time of induction and at least once in a year for all its health care workers and others involved in handling of bio- medical waste and maintain the records for the same;
- 13. Maintain and update on day to day basis the bio-medical waste management register and display the monthly record on its website according to the bio-medical waste generated in terms of category and colour coding as specified in Schedule I;
- 14. Inform the Prescribed Authority immediately in case the operator of a facility does not collect the bio-medical waste within the intended time or as per the agreed time;
- Establish a system to review and monitor the activities related to bio-medical waste management.

Terms and conditions of authorisation

- 16. The authorisation shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made there under.
- 17. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the prescribed authority.
- 18. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the biomedical wastes without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
- 19. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
- 20. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
- For hot water and other requirements install Solar Water Heater in a phased manner within one year. Install Rain Water Harvesting structures to recharge Ground water.
- 22. Switchover to Energy Efficient lightings and also for the heating and cooling requirements

Sub: Avoidance of 'PVC Flex Banners' - Reg.

Pondicherry University is initiating an action oriented program for the 'Elimination of Plastic from Pondicherry University' by implementing the Plastic Waste Management Rules (2016); Solid Waste Management Rules (2016); National Water Framework Act (2016); Sustainable Development Goals (2016); Green Protocol (2018) and UGCs Notification - 'Participation in 'Swachhata Hi Sewa Campaign' (2019).

Among various forms of plastic wastes generated, 'PVC Flex Banners' being a popular medium of communication is of significance. The hazardous nature of 'PVC Flex Banners', and the 'reason to adopt for cotton banner', could be seen at 'Environment Education cum Awareness Literature' (Appendix - A). The following are the recommendations for reduction of waste from this source:

- It is recommended that those, who use 'PVC flex materials' for printing/sourcing -Banners, Front lit banner, Exhibit Display, Standee, Flag, Backdrop, Mural, Hoarding, Board, Signage, Wallpaper, etc, switch to '100% Cotton Materials' where ever possible.
- Further, after use the materials may immediately be transformed into various end use bags (Appendix - B) or to any other useful/ creative objects.
- It is recommended that, the old 'PVC Flex Banners' that are in the University Departments may be handed over to the Coordinator, Office of Green Campus, Student Welfare Building, PU for proper handling/ disposal.
- The Civil Engineering Wing should provide place to store the same.
