As per the decision of the Competent Authority of the Pondicherry University, the Executive Council, Shri B. R Babu, IAS, Registrar on Deputation basis was relieved in the fore noon of 31.08.2017 vide office order no. 85 (PU/ESTT/NT/2017-18/143) dated 31.08.2017. **(Enclosure-I)**





Sub: First Information Report by the Anti Corruption Bureau of the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) in relation to a case against Shri B.R. Babu, IAS, who has been re-employed as Registrar, on Contract basis – Relieved from the post of Registrar – Orders Issued.

Whereas Shri B. R Babu joined Pondicherry University as Registrar (on deputation basis) on the AN of 14.07.2017 and was serving as Registrar until the Fore Noon of 31.08.2017 and subsequently he was re-employed as Registrar on contractual basis with effect from 01.09.2017 FN vide Reference No.PU/Estt/NT10/2017-18/144 dated 31.08.2017 cited above (Order no 86). Prior to joining the University he was working as Secretary to Government (Health), Government of Puducherry.

Whereas the Chief Rector of Pondicherry University and the Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry has forwarded a message to the Vice Chancellor through WhatsApp about filing of First Information Report by the Anti Corruption Bureau of the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Shri B. R Babu while he was serving the Government of Puducherry as Secretary to Government (Health).

Whereas, the FIR No. RC MAI 2017 A 0020 dated 18.09.2017 has named Shri B. R Babu, IAS the then Secretary to Government of Puducherry (Health) as accused no 3. The FIR states that it is evident that Accused 1 to Accused 6 (wherein Shri B. R Babu is Accused 3) and other unknown public servants abused their official position in pursuance of a criminal conspiracy entered with Accused 7 to Accused 13 and facilitated the private medical colleges to admit students for the PG courses even though, they were not sponsored by CENTAC which resulted in frustrating genuine students losing opportunity to continue higher education and ineligible students admitted.

Whereas, further the FIR states that thereby Accused 1 to Accused 13 (wherein Shri B. R Babu is Accused 3) conspired together during the year 2017 in furtherance of that they have cheated the bonafide students in the matter of admissions in PG courses in the UT of Puducherry by giving admissions to ineligible candidates for collecting exorbitant admission fee etc. Public servants 1 to Accused 6 (wherein Shri B. R Babu is Accused 3) failed to exercise that proper admission

procedure and facilitated the management of the Medical colleges by abusing their official position.

Whereas, further the FIR concludes that the above acts of Accused 1 to Accused 6 (wherein Shri B. R Babu is Accused 3) prima facie constitutes commission of cognizable offence punishable U/s 120-B r/w 420 IPC and Sec.132 (2) r/w Sec.13 (1)(d) of the Prevent of corruption Act, 1988.


Whereas, Pondicherry University grants affiliation to all the colleges run in the U T of Puducherry, including the private medical colleges named in the above said FIR and given the nexus between the management of these private colleges and Shri B. R Babu, the continuance of Shri B. R Babu as Registrar can jeopardize the interests of the University.

Whereas, Ordinance no 1, Part III, Clause (9) (ii) of Administrative Ordinance states that the Executive Council has the power to re-employ persons who have worked under the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Government or other Universities and who have retired from service on superannuation or on other grounds except on invalid grounds. Further it also states that states that the over-riding consideration by the Executive Council for grant of extension/re-employment is that it must be in the interest of the University.

Whereas, the continuance of an accused by CBI in a case related to admission of ineligible students to PG course without following the laid down procedures, in furtherance of a criminal conspiracy with private medical colleges should not cause any apprehension about the genuineness of admission process carried out in Pondicherry University.

Therefore, Shri B. R Babu, the Registrar who has been re-employed on contractual basis is relieved form the post of Registrar immediately with effect from the FN of 21.09.2017.



A reliable information is received to the effect that Public servants A-1 to A-6, who are officials of Govt. of Puducherry and other unknown Public servants entered into a criminal conspiracy with A-7 to A-13, in Puducherry and other places during March-July 2017, in the matter of admission of students in the PG Medical courses in Puducherry, and in furtherance of the criminal conspiracy, the accused Public Servants abused their official position and cheated the bonafide students who were issued with provisional admission certificate during counseling by Central Admission Committee (CENTAC) denying them the seat which they were otherwise allocated after admission process and facilitated the Private Medical colleges to admit students who were not sponsored by CENTAC collecting exorbitant fees thereby depriving the genuine candidates.

The Ministry of Health, Government of India vide Circular V. No.11025/2016/MEP Dt.5-12-2016 and 21-2-2017 and later Vide Circular No. FFV/11011//1/2015-MEP (Pt) dated 10-3-2017, directed the Chief Secretaries of all the States and Union Territories, that it is mandatory to have common counseling for admission to UG and PG courses in all medical institutions in the State by the Government concerned and there shall be no exemption from common counseling and all institutions including private medical colleges and deemed universities shall be covered under it and counseling for admission in common courses should be organized by State/Central Government based on the marks obtained in National Eligibility Entrance Test. Accordingly, Govt. of Puducherry vide Order dt.25-2-2017, entrusted CENTAC with the work relating to the PG admission in Medical colleges in the UT of Puducherry.



Dr. V. Govindaraj, Convenor, CENTAC, Dr. K. Pajaniradja @ Kichena, Joint Convenor, CENTAC and Dr.M. Jonathan Daniel, Co-ordinator, CENTAC were the officials involved in counseling. Shri Narendra Kumar, IAS is the Chairman of CENTAC and also the Development Commissioner of Puducherry. Dr. Raman is the Director of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of Puducherry and Dr. B.R. Babu is the Secretary (Health) of Govt. of Puducherry who were coordinators between the CENTAC and private medical colleges.

The Medical colleges in Puducherry have 318 Post Graduation/ Diploma seats in Medicines, of which 162 seats are earmarked as Govt. Quota seats and rest of 156 are earmarked as Management seats. For PG Medical admission, 267 candidates have applied against 162 Govt. Quota and 1827 candidates have applied against 156 Management quota seats. The process of counseling for 2017-18 was conducted by CENTAC (Centralised Admission Committee), under the guidance of Ministry of Health, Govt. of Puducherry.

The first phase of counseling was conducted by CENTAC (Centralised Admission Committee) on 4th and 11-5-2017 and the second phase of counseling was held on 19-5-2017. The counseling was conducted by Dr. V. Govindaraj, Convenor, CENTAC, Dr. K. Pajaniradja @ Kichena, Joint Convenor, CENTAC and Dr.M. Jonathan Daniel, Co-ordinator, CENTAC. A mop up counseling was held on 29-5-2017 and a final counseling was held on 31-5-2017. In pursuance of the criminal conspiracy, the first phase of counseling was held without even notification of fee, which was later intimated on 14-5-2017 ie. after completion of first phase of counseling. The Fee Committee appointed by Govt. of Puducherry was headed by Retired Justice Rajasekaran.

In furtherance of the criminal conspiracy, though CENTAC issued Provisional Admission Certificate, no efforts were made by A-1 to A-3 to verify the number of students who have not joined against the provisional admission certificate, and for the second round of counseling, the existing



vacancies due to refusal of the seven medical colleges (four deemed universities and three self financing colleges) to admit students even though the students are issued Provisional admission certificate by CENTAC, were not considered and while calculating the vacancy position, it was shown by CENTAC counseling authorities A- 4 to A-6 in the CENTAC web sites as if all the students who have issued with provisional admission certificate by CENTAC were admitted in the colleges.

In pursuance of the Criminal conspiracy, even though the fees committee issued a revised order on 24-5-2017, increasing the fees substantially, which can be charged from Govt. quota and Management quota students in respect of three self financing colleges, all the three colleges have refused admission to bona fide students and instead admitted students who have not even sponsored by CENTAC, by taking huge fees that had been mentioned in the website of the medical colleges ranging from Rs 40 to 50 Lakhs.

Similarly, in respect of four deemed universities, even though the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High court of Madras vide order dt. 16-6-2017 in WP No.14232/2017 directed the Deemed Universities to admit students who were issued with provisional admission certificates by CENTAC, by taking a initial fee of Rs.10 lacs per student and allowed the deemed universities to collect the balance fee depending upon the fee structure to be decided by University Grants Commission, all the four deemed universities have refused admission to the bona fide students and instead admitted students who have not even sponsored by CENTAC, by taking huge Fees.

For the admission in the PG Medical course, bona fide students, who have applied to CENTAC and who were given provisional allotment in the above seven medical colleges by CENTAC were not admitted by the Private Medical colleges and it is reliably learnt that the candidates who have paid huge fees were admitted against the seats which were allotted to other bona

vide students by CENTAC, thereby depriving the eligible students their legitimate right to pursue their higher medical education, and further leaving their career at jeopardy.



The above acts of A-1 to A-13 prima facie constitutes commission of cognizable offences punishable U/s 120-B r/w 420 IPC and Sec. 13(2) r/w Sec. 13(1)(d) of the P.C. Act, 1988 and hence this FIR.



Whereas Shri B. R Babu joined Pondicherry University as Registrar (on deputation basis) on the AN of 14.07.2017 and was serving as Registrar until the Fore Noon of 31.08.2017 and subsequently he was re-employed as Registrar on contractual basis with effect from 01.09.2017 FN vide Reference No.PU/Estt/NT10/2017-18/144 dated 31.08.2017 cited above (Order no 86). Prior to joining the University he was working as Secretary to Government (Health), Government of Puducherry.

Whereas the Chief Rector of Pondicherry University and the Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry has forwarded a message to the Vice Chancellor through WhatsApp about filing of First Information Report by the Anti Corruption Bureau of the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Shri B. R Babu while he was serving the Government of Puducherry as Secretary to Government (Health).

Whereas, the FIR No. RC MAI 2017 A 0020 dated 18.09.2017 has named Shri B. R Babu, IAS the then Secretary to Government of Puducherry (Health) as accused no 3. The FIR states that it is evident that Accused 1 to Accused 6 (wherein Shri B. R Babu is Accused 3) and other unknown public servants abused their official position in pursuance of a criminal conspiracy entered with Accused 7 to Accused 13 and facilitated the private medical colleges to admit students for the PG courses even though, they were not sponsored by CENTAC which resulted in frustrating genuine students losing opportunity to continue higher education and ineligible students admitted.

Whereas, further the FIR states that thereby Accused 1 to Accused 13 (wherein Shri B. R Babu is Accused 3) conspired together during the year 2017 in furtherance of that they have cheated the bonafide students in the matter of admissions in PG courses in the UT of Puducherry by giving admissions to ineligible candidates for collecting exorbitant admission fee etc. Public servants 1 to Accused 6 (wherein Shri B. R Babu is Accused 3) failed to exercise that proper admission

procedure and facilitated the management of the Medical colleges by abusing their official position.

Whereas, further the FIR concludes that the above acts of Accused 1 to Accused 6 (wherein Shri B. R. Babu is Accused 3) prima facie constitutes commission of cognizable offence punishable U/s 120-B r/w 420 IPC and Sec.132 (2) r/w Sec.13 (1)(d) of the Prevent of corruption Act, 1988.

Whereas, Pondicherry University grants affiliation to all the colleges run in the U T of Puducherry, including the private medical colleges named in the above said FIR and given the nexus between the management of these private colleges and Shri B. R. Babu, the continuance of Shri B. R. Babu as Registrar can jeopardize the interests of the University.

Whereas, Ordinance no 1, Part III, Clause (9) (ii) of Administrative Ordinance states that the Executive Council has the power to re-employ persons who have worked under the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Government or other Universities and who have retired from service on superannuation or on other grounds except on invalid grounds. Further it also states that states that the over-riding consideration by the Executive Council for grant of extension/re-employment is that it must be in the interest of the University.

Whereas, the continuance of an accused by CBI in a case related to admission of ineligible students to PG course without following the laid down procedures, in furtherance of a criminal conspiracy with private medical colleges should not cause any apprehension about the genuineness of admission process carried out in Pondicherry University.

Therefore, Shri B. R. Babu, the Registrar who has been re-employed on contractual basis is relieved from the post of Registrar immediately with effect from the FN of 21.09.2017.
