**TO CONSIDER THE ORDERS OF THE MHRD REGARDING THE EMPOWERMENT OF SPORTSPERSONS BY PROVIDING EMPLOYMENT IN THE UNIVERSITY**

The Ministry of Human Resource Development vide its letters No.M.11013/25/2016-CDN dated 08.12.2016 and F.No.20-11/2017-CU.Cdn. dated 27.03.2017 has enclosed a copy of D.O. letter No.14-21/2016-SP-VI dated 25.11.2016 received from the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India **[ENCLOSURE-I]**.

In the above said letter dated 25.11.2016, the Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent charge), Youth Affairs and Sports has requested to initiate a scheme/programme in the Ministry/Department and the Organizations under the Ministry control, to encourage the sports persons and to give jobs to the deserving sports persons. Further, in case no such initiative has been made so far, it has been requested to initiate a scheme/programme and Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports would render assistance in this regard **[ENCLOSURE-II]**.

As per the general orders of the Government of India on Reservations and Concessions *"No specific percentage of reservation is prescribed for meritorious sportspersons, Ministries/Departments can recruit meritorious sportspersons in any year against vacancies not exceeding 5%, in relaxation of the recruitment procedure, provided the overall reservations of all types do not exceed 50% of the total number of vacancies.*  
***Posts Applicable : - Group 'C' / 'D' post filled by direct recruitment. No reservation is permitted in direct recruitment to Group 'A' / 'B' posts. No reservation is permitted in promotion"*** (Swamy's – Reservation and Concessions) **[ENCLOSURE-III]**.

Hence, it is proposed to follow the rules and guidelines on "Reservation and Concessions" for meritorious sportspersons for this purpose in the University to provide jobs to the sportspersons. In case of consideration of this scheme horizontal reservation shall be applied as followed in the case of PWD/Ex-Servicemen.

Further it is also submitted that the above said matter was placed before the 126<sup>th</sup> meeting the Executive Council in its meeting held on 31.08.2017 (Res.No.2017.126.124) and the council has deferred the matter.

Hence, it is re-submitted for consideration and decision of the Executive Council.

### 5. Reservations for Meritorious Sportspersons [ Swamy's — Reservations and Concessions ]

1. Eligibility.— (i) Persons who have represented a State or the country in the National or International competition in any of the games / sports listed below.

(ii) Their University in the Inter-University Tournaments conducted by the Inter-University Sports Board in any of these games.

(iii) The State Schools Teams in the National Sports / Games conducted by the All India School Games Federation in any of these games / sports.

(iv) Persons who have been awarded National Awards in Physical Efficiency under National Physical Efficiency Drive.

List of Games / Sports.— Archery, Athletics (including Track and Field events), Atya-Patya, Badminton, Ball-Badminton, Basketball, Billiards and Snooker, Boxing, Bridge, Carrom, Chess, Cricket, Cycling, Equestrian Sports, Football, Golf, Gymnastics (including Body-Building), Handball, Hockey, Judo, Kabaddi, Karate-DO, Kayaking and Canoeing, Kho-Kho, Polo, Powerlifting, Rifle Shooting, Roller Skating, Rowing, Softball, Squash, Swimming, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Tennikoit, Tennis, Volleyball, Weight-lifting, Wrestling, Yachting, Ice-Skiing, Ice-Hockey and Ice-Skating.— Appendix-1 of Section 5.

2. Extent of reservation.— No specific percentage of reservation is prescribed. Ministries / Departments can recruit meritorious sportspersons in any year against vacancies not exceeding 5%, in relaxation of the recruitment procedure, provided the overall reservations of all types do not exceed 50% of the total number of vacancies.

3. Posts to which reservation applicable.— Group 'C'/'D' post filled by direct recruitment otherwise than through the UPSC. No reservation is permitted in direct recruitment to Group 'A'/'B' posts. Appointing authorities at their discretion may notify vacancies reduced up to 5% for being filled by direct recruitment of sportsperson. No reservation preference is permitted in promotions. The fact may be taken into account in assessing the overall merit.

4. Recruitment procedure.— Ministries / Departments may consider applications received from meritorious sportspersons duly supported by the certificates awarded by the specified authorities. If they are satisfied that the candidate fulfils the eligibility criteria and also the minimum educational qualifications, etc., appointment may be made.

5. Placement in the reservation roster.— Sportsperson so appointed will be adjusted in the reservation roster of SC/ST/OBC/General category to which he belongs. For example if the candidate belongs to SC, adjustment will be against the point reserved for SC.

6. Age Relaxations.— Maximum age limit may be relaxed by five years (10 years for SCs/STs and 5 years for OBCs) for appointment to all Groups of Civil posts / services filled otherwise than through competitive examinations conducted by the UPSC.— Section 3, UBL.

**TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE DPC MEETING HELD ON 29.12.2014 REGARDING PROMOTION OF SHRI V. SHANMUGAM, JUNIOR ASSISTANT (RETD.) TO THE POST OF ASSISTANT, WHICH WAS KEPT IN SEALED COVER DUE TO PENDING DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AGAINST HIM**

The Minutes of the DPC meeting held on 29.12.2014 in respect of Shri V. Shanmugam is enclosed **(ENCLOSURE-I)**.

The Departmental Promotion Committee for Group 'B & C' posts in its meeting held on 29.12.2014 has assessed that Shri V. Shanmugam, Junior Assistant (Retired) was found fit for promotion to the post of Assistant after perusal of his APARs and other relevant records, subject to final outcome of the disciplinary proceedings pending against him. Also recommended that if any penalty imposed on Shri V. Shanmugam as result of the disciplinary proceedings, his case for promotion may be considered by the next DPC as normal course having regard with the penalty imposed on him as per rules. The committee also noted that Shri V. Shanmugam would retire on 31.12.2014 afternoon.

Recordable warning was served upon Shri V. Shanmugam vide Memorandum No.PU/ESTT/NT-3/AR(Vig.)/2014-15/23 dated 09.04.2015 **(ENCLOSURE-II)** taking into consideration that he has retired on 31.12.2014 and also other extenuating factors involved in the matter.

In view of the final outcome in his case i.e. giving him a severe warning and closure of the enquiry file against him is to be treated that as there is no penalty against him.

Hence, as recommended by the Departmental Promotion Committee, Shri V. Shanmugam may be promoted to the post of Assistant with Grade Pay of ₹ 2,400/- on 31.12.2014 [i.e. the date on which his immediate Junior viz. Shri M. Vetrivelou had been promoted] **(ENCLOSURE-III)**.

**Facts on MACP:**

It may also be noted that the Screening Committee for MACP in its meeting held on 29.09.2010 and 06.10.2010 has scrutinized the service records and ACR dossiers of all eligible Junior Assistants and recommended for award of financial upgradation under MACP/ACP w.e.f. due dates except Shri V. Shanmugam and three others. Again the Screening Committee for MACP in its meeting held on 22.06.2011 has scrutinized the service records and ACR dossiers of two employees viz., Shri V. Shanmugam and Shri M. Eganathan and recommended Shri V. Shanmugam as 'Not fit'.



Further the Minutes of the Screening Committee held on 20.02.2016 for award of MACP was not completed due to administrative reasons and the matter will be taken to next sitting of MACP Committee afresh.

**Facts regarding promotion on the date of retirement:**

As per DOPT Office Memorandum dated 25.01.2016 **(ENCLOSURE-IV)**, *“the Government Servant, who has retired by the time he is exonerated of all the charges has been considered in respect of the following cases:*

- i. Where the promotion order pertaining to the relevant DPC has been issued and the officers empanelled have assumed charge prior to the date of superannuation of the retired Government Servant; and*
- ii. The retired Government Servant would have been in service and assumed charge of the post had the disciplinary proceeding not been initiated against him/her.*

*Also a retired Government employee who is considered for notional promotion from the date of promotion of his next junior after opening of the sealed cover would also be entitled to fixation of pension on the basis of such notional pay on his notional promotion”.*

In view of the above, as recommended by the DPC and as per sealed cover procedures, Shri V. Shanmugam is eligible for promotion. The same procedure was approved in respect of Shri V. Manibalan and Shri V. Gowrisankar.

Further it is also submitted that the above said matter was placed before the 124<sup>th</sup> meeting the Executive Council in its meeting held on 16.02.2017 (Res.No.2017.124.67) and the council has deferred the matter.

Hence, it is re-submitted for consideration and approval of the Executive Council.



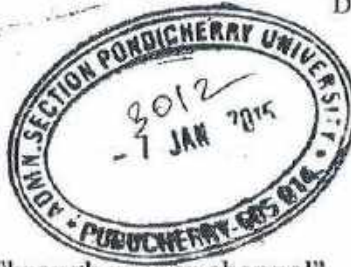

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject:- Promotion of Govt. Servants exonerated after retirement – Procedure and Guidelines to be followed - Regarding.**

The undersigned is directed to invite reference to the Department of Personnel and Training Office Memorandum No. 22011/4/91-Estt(A) dated 14<sup>th</sup> September, 1992 regarding procedure and guidelines to be followed by DPC in respect of Government servants against whom disciplinary/court proceedings are pending or whose conduct is under investigation. In case the Government servant is covered under any of the three conditions as mentioned in Para 2 of OM dated 14.09.1992, the recommendations of the DPC are to be kept in 'sealed cover' and subsequent action regarding opening of sealed cover will depend on the outcome of the disciplinary/criminal proceedings.

2. If on conclusion of the disciplinary/ criminal proceedings, the Government servant is exonerated, the procedure prescribed in para 3 of the OM dated 14-9-1992 is to be followed. This provides as under:-

"On the conclusion of the disciplinary case/criminal prosecution which results in dropping of allegations against the Govt. servant, the sealed cover or covers shall be opened. In case the Government servant is completely exonerated the due date of his promotion will be determined with reference to the position assigned to him in the findings kept in the sealed cover/covers and with reference to the date of promotion of his next junior on the basis of such position. The Government servant may be promoted, if necessary, by reverting the junior most officiating person. He may be promoted notionally with reference to the date of promotion of his junior. However, whether the officer concerned will be entitled to any arrears of pay for the period of notional promotion preceding the date of actual promotion, and if so to what extent, will be decided by the appointing authority by taking into consideration all the facts and circumstances of the disciplinary proceedings/criminal prosecution. Where the authority denies arrears of salary or part of it, it will record its reasons for doing so. It is not possible to anticipate and enumerate exhaustively all the circumstances under which such denials of arrears of salary or part of it may become necessary. However, there may be cases where the proceedings, whether disciplinary or criminal, are, for example delayed at the instance of the employee or the clearance in the disciplinary proceedings or acquittal in the criminal proceedings is with benefit of doubt or on account of non-availability of evidence due to the acts attributable to the employee etc. These are only some of the circumstances where such denial can be justified."

3. The applicability of above provisions in so far as it relates to cases where the Government Servant, who has retired by the time he is exonerated of all the charges has been considered in respect of the following cases:

- i. Where the promotion order pertaining to the relevant DPC has been issued and the officers empanelled have assumed charge prior to the date of superannuation of the retired Government Servant; and
- ii. The retired Government Servant would have been in service and assumed charge of the post had the disciplinary proceeding not been initiated against him/her.

4. It has been decided in consultation with the Department of Expenditure, Department of Pensions & Pensioners' Welfare and the Department of Legal Affairs that notional promotion and payment of arrears of pay, if any, for the period of notional promotion till the date of retirement, to such a retired Government servant if found fit on opening of the sealed cover is to be decided by the appointing authority in terms of Para 3 of OM No.22011/4/91-Estt(A) dated 14/9/1992.

5. A retired Government employee who is considered for notional promotion from the date of promotion of his next junior after opening of the sealed cover would also be entitled to fixation of pension on the basis of such notional pay on his notional promotion.



**TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE DPC MEETING HELD ON 09.02.2016 REGARDING PROMOTION OF SHRI S.L. MADJINI, JUNIOR ASSISTANT TO THE POST ASSISTANT, WHICH WAS KEPT IN SEALED COVER DUE TO PENDING DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AGAINST HIM**

The Minutes of the DPC meeting held on 09.02.2016 in respect of Shri S.L. Madjini is enclosed (**ENCLOSURE-I**).

The Departmental Promotion Committee for Group 'B & C' posts in its meeting held on 09.02.2016 has assessed that Shri S.L. Madjini, Junior Assistant was found fit for promotion to the post of Assistant after perusal of his APARs and other relevant records, subject to final outcome of the disciplinary proceedings pending against him. Also recommended that if any penalty imposed on Shri S.L. Madjini, Junior Assistant as a result of the disciplinary proceedings, his case for promotion may be considered by the next DPC in the normal course having regard to the penalty imposed on him as per rules.

Now simple warning was served to Shri S.L. Madjini vide Memorandum No.PU/ESTT/NT-3/1203/2016-17/59 dated 08.07.2016 (**ENCLOSURE-II**) taking into consideration that he would mend his behavior in future. He should also invariably obtain prior permission/sanction of leave in future, failing which stringent action would be taken as per rules.

In view of the final outcome in his case i.e. giving him a simple warning and closure of the enquiry file against him, it is to be treated that as there is no penalty against him. Hence, he is eligible for promotion as per the procedure and also as done in the cases of Shri V. Manibalan and Shri V. Gowrisankar.

In view of above, as recommended by the Departmental Promotion Committee, Shri S.L. Madjini may be promoted to the post of Assistant on regular basis with Grade Pay of ₹ 2,400/- notionally w.e.f. 01.03.2016 [i.e. w.e.f. the date of promotion of his immediate junior viz. Shri M.S. **TO CONSIDER THE REVISION IN THE FEE STRUCTURE OF THE STUDY INDIA PROGRAMME OFFERED FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS BY THE UNIVERSITY**

A committee was constituted by the University to review the fee structure of the Study India Programme offered for foreign students by the University. The Committee met on 27.04.2016 and recommended to increase the hostel fee from USD 150 to USD 300. The Committee recommended not to increase the present tuition fee(USD 500). The above item was placed in the 77<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting held on 03.10.2016, vide resolution No.2016.77.21 and the same was approved.

TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE RECOMMENDATIONS MADE BY THE LAW COMMITTEE ON THE ENHANCEMENT OF PROFESSIONAL FEES PAYABLE TO UNIVERSITY COUNSELS

The University Counsels at High Court Chennai were being paid a sum of Rs.3,500/- to 3,700/- per Writ Petition as fixed by the Executive Council in its 31<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 5.7.1991 in Resolution No.91.62, dated 5.7.1991. Subsequently, based on the requests made by the University Counsels to enhance the professional fee which remained constant during a period of more than 7 years, the Executive Council, in its 57<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 26.11.1998 in Resolution No.98.94, constituted a Committee to review the question of enhancement of fees to be paid to the University Counsels and to prepare panels of Advocates representing University cases in the Madras High Court and the Local Courts.

The recommendations made by the Law Committee were placed before the 59<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Council held on 8.10.1999 and were approved vide Resolution No.99.62. The Committee inter-alia recommended that the revised legal practitioners fee rules may be followed for cases in Local Courts/Consumer Forum/State Commission at Pondicherry and for Writ Petitions/Suits in Local Courts/Cases before Consumer Forum at Madras and also 20% of the fee be paid as clerical charges as provided under the above rules.

Professional fees could not be paid to the University Counsels as decided based on the revised Legal Practitioners fee rules, as these rules prescribe fees mainly to money suits and not for suits/writs on service matters or other matters.

in her letter dated 5.2.2000 has informed that the Legal practitioners fee rules is applicable only to original side suits and not for Writ petitions which come under the special original jurisdiction of High Court Madras. The matter was referred to Dr. S.G. Bhat, Chairman of the Law Committee requesting him to clarify on this issue. In response Dr. S.G. Bhat in his letter dated 7.3.2000 informed that the University may ascertain the fee paid to Counsels from Government of Pondicherry and the same fee may be paid to University Counsels. The pattern of fees paid by Government of Pondicherry to its Counsels could not be adopted by this University as the Government of Pondicherry has been paying fees to its counsels on a different pattern including retainer fee which is payable every month irrespective of the number of cases, whereas the University Counsels were being paid on case to case basis without any retainer fee. Therefore, a fresh committee was constituted with the following composition for considering enhancement of professional fees payable to University Counsels:



**TO RATIFY THE CONFIRMATION OF 47 EMPLOYEES IN THEIR ENTRY GRADE POST AS PER RULE 6(3) OF THE ORDINANCES GOVERNING TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THIS UNIVERSITY OTHER THAN TEACHERS**

As per rule 6(3) of the Ordinances Governing Terms and Conditions of Service of all Employees of the University other than Teachers, every person appointed to a permanent post under the University by direct recruitment shall on satisfactory completion of his/her period of probation be eligible for confirmation in that posts provided the University appointing authority has approved the appointment.

**(Enclosure-I)**

Further as per instruction of Government of India the confirmation of an employee has to be made only once in the service of an official which will be in the entry grade post/service/Cadre and it is de-linked from the availability of permanent vacancy in the grade. As per procedures, on completion of probation satisfactorily, an employees may be considered for confirmation in the entry grade and a specific confirmation order has to be issued when the case is cleared from all angles.

Accordingly the cases of employees eligible for confirmation were placed before the Departmental Promotion Committee for consideration of confirmation in the entry grade post and the Department promotion committee has recommended the eligible employees for confirmation in the entry grade post by examining their suitability from all angles and considering all other aspects.

It is submitted that the Council vide its resolution No.2010.103.42 dated 01.04.2010 while considering the confirmation of certain employees in the entry grade post has observed that in future, cases for confirmation may be approved at the Vice-Chancellor's level and thereafter brought to the Executive council for ratification. **(Enclosure-II)**

## ORDINANCES GOVERNING ADMINISTRATIVE MATTER

### RULE 8(3)

ENCLOSURE - 1

- (ii) to re-employ persons who have worked under the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Government or other Universities and who have retired from service on superannuation or on other grounds except on invalid grounds.
- (iii) to absorb permanently Government servants who have been on deputation to the University and to retain them on re-employment basis.

The over-riding consideration by the Executive Council for the grant of extension of service/re-employment is that it must be in the interest of the University and in addition satisfy one of the following two conditions:

- (a) that no suitable person could be made available from the lower cadre on promotion or there is shortage in that cadre;
- (b) that the retiring officer is of outstanding merit. Provided that no Officer shall be retained in the service of the University beyond two years from the date of superannuation prescribed by the University.

(10) Except as otherwise provided in these rules, the whole time of the employee of the University is at the disposal of the University which pays him and he may be employed in any manner required by proper authority without claim for additional remuneration.

- 5. (a) The absence of an employee of the University from duty, whether on leave or on foreign service shall not render him ineligible to the privileges in respect of seniority, promotion and confirmation which he would have enjoyed but for his absence if he is fit, otherwise. Employees absent from duty
- (b) No permanent employee shall be granted leave of any kind for a continuous period exceeding five years.
- (c) When an employee does not resume duty after remaining on leave for a continuous period of five years, or where an employee after the expiry of his leave remains absent from duty, otherwise than on foreign service or on account of suspension, or for any period which together with the period of the leave granted to him exceeds five years, he shall unless the Executive Council, in view of the exceptional circumstances of the case otherwise determines, be deemed to have resigned and shall accordingly cease to be in the University service.

### TENURE

6. (1) Every person appointed on regular basis to a post in the University whether by promotion or by direct recruitment, shall be on probation in that post for a period of two years. Probation and confirmation  
Provided that the appointing authority may, in any individual case, extend the period of probation for a further period not exceeding 2 years the reasons thereof to be recorded in writing.

(2) Where a person appointed to a post in the University on probation is, during his regular period of probation, or extended period of probation found unsuitable for holding that post or has not completed his period of probation satisfactorily the appointing authority may:

- (i) in the case of person appointed by promotion revert him to the post held by him immediately before such appointment; and

- (ii) In the case of a person appointed by direct recruitment terminate his services under the University without notice.
- (3) Every person appointed to a permanent post under the University by promotion or by direct recruitment shall, on satisfactory completion of his period of probation be eligible for confirmation in that post.
- (4) No employee shall be confirmed in any post unless—
- (i) the service of the employee under the University is approved by the Appointing Authority.
7. The seniority of an employee regularly appointed to a post according to rule shall be determined by the order of merit indicated at the time of initial appointment, provided that the relative seniority of all direct recruits shall be determined by the order of merit in which they are selected for such appointment on the recommendation of the duly constituted selecting authority irrespective of date of joining the post, persons appointed as a result of an earlier selection being senior to those appointed as a result of subsequent selection.
8. (i) An Employee shall be a temporary employee of the University until he is confirmed in a post under the University.
- (ii) An Employee confirmed in any post under the University shall be a permanent employee of the University.
9. (1) The Services of a temporary employee may be terminated by the Vice-Chancellor/ Executive Council without assigning any reason at any time by a notice of one month in writing given to the employee or forthwith by payment to him of a sum equivalent to the amount of his pay plus allowances for the period of the notice at the same rates at which he was drawing them immediately before the termination of his services, or as the case may be, for the period by which such notice falls short of one month.
- (2) The services of a permanent employee may be terminated by the Vice-Chancellor/ Executive Council at any time by a notice of three months or on payment of pay and allowances drawn by him immediately before the termination of his service for such period as the notice falls short of three months, or without notice on payment of three month's pay plus allowances drawn by him immediately before the termination of his service, if the post in which he was confirmed is abolished.
- (3) An employee who is given notice of termination of service under clause (2) may be granted, during the period of notice, such earned leave, as may be admissible to him, and, where the leave so admissible and granted is more than three months, his services shall be terminated on the expiry of such leave.
10. (1) Except as other wise provided in this rule, every employee of the University shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the month in which he attains the age of 60 years provided that an employee whose date of birth is the first of a month shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the preceding month on attaining the age of sixty years.
- (2) No employee shall be granted extension in service beyond the age of retirement of 60 years (save under special circumstances with the sanction of Executive Council).
