AGREEMENT FOR EXCHANGE OF

STUDENTS

between

The University of Tours France

and

Pondicherry University India

Considering the Articles D123-15 to D123-22 from the French Law of Education and the Bill °2015-668 of June 15th regarding international cooperation of public higher education establishments under the authority of the French Competent Ministries,

Considering the legislation in force in India and in the Indian Union Territory of Pondicherry,

BETWEEN

The University of Tours (hereafter referred to as UT), represented by its President, Prof. Arnaud GIACOMETTI, on the one hand,

AND

Pondicherry University (hereafter referred to as PU), represented by its Registrar, Prof. Amaresh SAMANTARAYA, on the other hand,

The following has been agreed:

1. PURPOSE

Being aware that the quality of their teaching is strengthened by the establishment of international cooperation links, Pondicherry University and the University of Tours wish to enter exchanges, with a view to their mutual enrichment on the scientific, academic and cultural levels.

The general objective of this Agreement is long-term educational collaboration in fields which are compatible with the orientation of each university, and which are relevant to the industrial, scientific, social and cultural interests and needs of the countries wherein the parties are respectively located.

The focus will be a collaboration between :

- PU : All Faculties
- UT: All Faculties with the exception of the Faculty of Medicine.

2. <u>ADMINISTRATION OF THE AGREEMENT AND MANNER OF</u> <u>IMPLEMENTATION</u>

The programme will be administered by :

- Dean, International Relations, & M.O.U. Coordinator PU
- Director, International Relations Office (IRO) UT

They will ensure that the study proceeds according to a reasonable schematic plan and ensure that the terms of this exchange program are carried out.

Both institutions agree to keep in regular contact through their respective international offices and to report progress or other specific information as requested.

3. <u>STUDY LEVELS</u>

Students concerned by the present Agreement are:

- undergraduate (Licence) students
- and/or graduate (Master) students

To be considered for acceptance by the host University, a student must fulfil the following conditions:

- Students from Tours must be registered at UT in an undergraduate or graduate program and will have completed one year of study in their home university.
- Students from Pondicherry must be registered at PU in an undergraduate or graduate program and will have completed one year of study in their home university.
- Students must have obtained overall satisfactory results as determined by the home university.

4. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE EXCHANGE.

It is anticipated that each year, an approximately equal number of students from each university will participate in the exchange. The number of students to be admitted to the program each year will be up to 3 students at each university. 2 students accepted for one semester are deemed to be the equivalent of 1 student per year for the purposes of calculating the total number of students eligible for exchange that year.

Each partner will endeavour to match the yearly number of outgoing and incoming exchange students. Should the exchange be unbalanced in number over a given year, the balance will be restored accordingly over the five-year validity period of the Agreement.

A learning agreement will be prepared and signed by both parties and the student before the beginning of the mobility.

5. STUDENT ADMISSION AND FOLLOW-UP

- a. Each university will select the students for the exchange from its own institution according to published criteria and procedures.
- b. Each university will present the applications of the selected students to the partner university who will be asked to approve the candidates and the study programs of the candidates.
- c. Each university will accept the admission requirements and registration procedure of the host university. The candidates will accept the rules, regulations and registration procedure of the host university in the matter of course choice.
- d. Students will be informed of their acceptance no later than 15 May of each year for the first semester (beginning in September) or the 15 November for second semester exchanges (beginning in January). They must confirm their intention to accept or reject the offer by 15 June or 30 November.
- e. If an accepted candidate declines, the universities may offer the place to an alternate candidate.
- f. The host institution undertakes to establish the appropriate admission certificate with the student's name enabling him/her to enter the host country as an exchange student.
- g. Students from both universities must have their course selections approved by their home department and appropriate academic authorities, in order to obtain transfer of credit towards their degrees.
- h. The host institution will not require students to take courses beyond those agreed above.

i. Each university will provide the other with transcript records of the student's results. The home university will give credits for all or part of the courses followed by the student in the host university according to his/her results.

6. STUDENT REGISTRATION

- a. Students from both universities will register in their university of origin.
- b. Students will pay registration fees to their home university.
- c. Exchange students will not be charged tuition fees by the host institution, but may be required to pay certain ancillary fees as specified by each institution. They will be responsible for their own travel and subsistence expenses.

7. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Courses at PU are taught mainly in English (except in the Dept of French). The list of courses available for exchange students can be found on the university website, as per the School and Dept (link on www.pondiuni.edu.in home page, under "Academics").

Courses at UT are taught in French and/or English. The list of courses available for exchange students can be found on: http://cces.univ-tours.fr/ or http://polytech.univ-tours.fr/international/exchange-program

Students will be required to meet the language proficiency requirements of the Host University.

To meet admission conditions at PU, UT students should provide sufficient proof of English language proficiency as certified by the home university.

To meet admission conditions in UT, PU students should provide sufficient proof of French language proficiency. For exchange programs in French, students should have reached B2 of the European Common Frame of Reference, meaning:

Level 3 TCF: TCF B2 (399 points minimum)

Level 3 TEF: TEF B2 (540 points minimum)

DELF B2,

Or give proof of sufficient language proficiency, as certified by the home university.

In addition to meeting admission conditions at UT, non-French speaking students who come to UT for courses delivered in English, a supervised project, or an internship in English in an Engineering or Science program are not subject to French proficiency requirements.

8. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

All students participating in this exchange program:

a. must be full-time students at the host university in program of studies or participate in an internship. Their internship or studies program must also be validated by the home university.

b. must abide by the rules and regulations of the host university, including compliance with all laws of the host country. Violation of these laws shall subject the student to immediate expulsion.

c. are responsible for obtaining any necessary visa and otherwise complying with all immigration laws and regulations in the host country;

d. must have access to university restaurants at the same rates as those applied to students from the host university. The host university will assist students to find accommodations and to become integrated in their new social environment. Such assistance shall not include financial assistance.

e. must immediately inform the International Office at the home and host university, as well as the staff responsible for the exchange, in the event of any problem, early departure or any modification of the terms of the exchange or in his/her learning agreement.

9. INSURANCE

All exchange students:

- a. must have adequate insurance coverage against risks sustained when living abroad;
- b. are required to take, at their own expense, suitable health insurance which covers and provides health care, hospital fees and repatriation, providing adequate proof of this to the host university. Medical insurance can be provided by the host university. If such insurance is not taken out, the student must provide proof to the host university that he/she has equivalent medical coverage. The student agrees that the host university is not responsible for any personal injury, loss or damage suffered by the exchange participant in case of medical emergency or force majeure.

10. DURATION

This Agreement will be enforceable after signature by both parties and approval by competent authorities. It will be valid for a period of five years, unless otherwise revoked by either party, provided six months written notice be given. In case of renewal, it will be further resubmitted for the approval by the competent authorities in both institutions, in compliance with current legislation.



11. <u>AMENDMENTS</u>

Any modification to the current text, decided by both contracting parties, will be subject to an amendment signed by the parties and must be submitted for the approval by the competent authorities.

12. TERMINATION

a. Termination for fault. – Each Party may terminate this Agreement unilaterally in case of non-compliance by the other Party with its essential obligations, by registered letter with acknowledgement of receipt. The termination will be effective six months after sending this letter, postmark date and stamp used as proof. The breaching party is not entitled to claim any compensation.

Prior to exercising discretion, the party using its unilateral termination power must seek redress, in an adversarial procedure, after providing a formal notice from the cocontracting party, within a period determined by this party, asking to act as soon as possible to remedy the situation and to send the co-contracting party any information that could justify the breaches. Unilateral termination rights can then only take place in the event there is no successful mediation dialogue between the parties.

b. Termination for any other reason - Both parties expressly reserve the right to unilaterally terminate this Agreement for any other duly justified reason. The most diligent party notifies the other party of its decision by registered letter with acknowledgment of receipt, subject to a six-months' notice period before the end of the current academic year. The termination takes effect at the end of this academic year. As a consequence of a unilateral decision to terminate, the non-breaching party is not entitled to claim any compensation.

13. GOVERNING LAW

Any claim or dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of the country in which the Institution which is the defendant is located. Each Institution irrevocably submits to the jurisdiction of the courts of the country where the defendant institution is located.

Pursuant to Article 46 EU GDPR, "Transfers subject to appropriate safeguards", data transfer will only be possible after having concluded a transfer agreement on personal data between the two universities according to the standard contractual clauses for data transfers adopted by the European Commission.

14. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

Both institutions subscribe to the policy of Equal Opportunity and will not discriminate on the basis of ethnicity, age, religion, nationality or sexual orientation. Both institutions shall

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abide by these principles in the administration of this Agreement and neither institution shall impose criteria for the exchange of students which would violate the principles of non-discrimination.

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



between

UniversityofTours (France)

and

Pondicherry University (India)

Considering the Articles D123-15 to D123-22 from the French Law of Education and the Bill °2015-668 of June 15th regarding international cooperation of public higher education establishments under the authority of the French Competent Ministries,

Considering the legislation in force in India and in the Indian Union Territory of Pondicherry,

Desirous of developing a friendly relationship between France andIndia, the University of Tours and Pondicherry University have decided to enter the following Agreement so as to promote exchanges between the above-mentioned universities.

- The partners will endeavour, whenever possible, to encourage contact and cooperation in the fields of tuition and/or research between their different departments. They will collaborate in fields that are within their scope of competence, such as:
 - Joint research and tuitionactivities:
 - Exchange of university documentation and publications;
 - Exchange of faculty members for researchpurposes:
 - Student exchanges (study abroad program, supervised project and internship), providing students fulfil the universities requirements for enrolment.
- The themes of the joint projects and the terms for the exchanges will be negotiated case by case, and will be finalised by separate agreements which will detail the implementation and financing of each individual project, taking into account the availability of funds of each university.
- 3. The present Agreement will become valid after signature by both parties and approval by the relevant authorities. This Agreement will be effective for a period of five (5) years. The relevant authorities must approve renewal.
- 4. This MOU is only to express the intentions of the Parties. The expressed intentions are not binding and no legally binding obligations are intended to, or do arise as a consequence of the signing of this MOU. Actions taken by either Party in reliance on this MOU will be at that Party's sole risk. Both parties acknowledge that this MOU and all subsequent agreements shall comply with all applicable laws, policies, and procedures.

TO APPRISE THE COUNCIL ON THE CANCELLATION OF THE EWS CERTIFICATE IN RESPECT OF SHRI. LOVEROOP SINGH, ASSISTANT REGISTRAR (SINCE RESIGNED), PONDICHERRY UNIVERSITY BY DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER (COMPLAINT BRANCH), AMRITSAR

Shri. Loveroop Singh was selected for the post of Assistant Registrar on direct recruitment against EWS category by a duly constituted Selection Committee in its meeting which was based on his application in response to open advertisement and his performance in the interview (Annexure-1). In support of his claim against EWS category he had uploaded the certificate in the prescribed format issued by the Dept. of Social Justice, Empowerment and Minorities, Govt. of Punjab, O/o the Tahsildar, Amritsar, Punjab along with online application.

He reported for duty for the post of Assistant Registrar on 11.06.2021 (Annexure-2). The appointment to the post of Assistant Registrar was provisional, subject to verification of certificates. The EWS certificate submitted by Shri. Loveroop Singh was sent to the Tahsildar, Amritsar-1, District Amritsar, Punjab for issue of genuineness, as per norms of Govt. of India for fresh recruitments vide letter dated 23.08.2021 (Annexure-3). Reminders were also sent on 19.01.2022 & 29.03.2022.

Further, a letter dated 07.03.2022 was sent to the District Collector, District Amritsar, Punjab with a request to arrange to send the genuiness of EWS – Asset Certificate in respect of Shri. Loveroop Singh (Annexure-4). However communication dated 14.03.2022 was received from the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Amritsar wherein it was mentioned that "To Whom it may concerned" certified that No.ASR/IAC/2020/N/11002319, dated 22.07.2020 and ASR/IAC/2021/N/22988435, dated 19.08.2021 [Income and Asset Certificate (EWS) issued by the office of Tehsildar Amritsar-II in r/o Shri. Loveroop Singh] has been cancelled by the order of the Tehsildar, Amritsar-II (Annexure-5).

Again, the Tasildhar, O/o the Tahsildar, Amritsar-1Distrcict Amritsar, Punjab was requested vide University letter dated 29.03.2022 to certify the genuineness of the Income and Asset Certificate (EWS) in respect of Shri. Loveroop Singh, since the specific communication address to the University is not mentioned in that communication (Annexure-6).

In response to this office letter dated 07.03.2022, the Deputy Commissioner, o/o the Deputy Commissioner (Complaint Branch), Amritsar has replied vide his letter dated 19.04.2022 that an inquiry was conducted by the concerned Sub Divisional Magistrate, Amritsar in respect of certificate of Shri. Loveroop Singh, in which the certificate was found to be incorrect, in which Hon'ble Sub Divisional Magistrate, Amritsar-2, Tehsildar, Amritsar-2 and E.District Technical Coordinator certificates have been cancelled **(Annexure-7).**

He has also informed that certificates issued to Shri. Loveroop Singh S/o Shri. Upkar Singh are cancelled because were found incorrect.

As per DoPT office Memorandum No.360/11/1/2012-Estt.(Res.), dated 10.01.2013, "Wherever it is found that a Government servant, who was not qualified or eligible in terms of the recruitment rules etc., for initial recruitment in service or had furnished false certificate in order to secure appointment, he should not be retained in service. If, he is probationer or a temporary Government servant, he should be discharged or his services should be terminated (Annexure-8).

In the meanwhile, Shri.Loveroop Singh submitted his resignation on 13.01.2022 from the post of Assistant Registrar of this University on personal reasons and relieved of his duties of Pondicherry University w.e.f. 12.04.2022 (Annexure-9).

The following are the amendments:

- 1. The mode of grant operation between South Asia Foundation(SAF) and Pondicherry University in line with the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act(FCRA) 2020 guidelines of Govt. of India that certain components of scholarship are to be directly transferred to SAF students upon raising the bills by PU and certain components of scholarship to be transferred to PU or its agents upon raise of bills by PU.
- 2. It is agreed to increase number of SAF students intake from 8 to 16 from South Asian countries.
- 3. It is agreed to enhance the amount of monthly stipend from Rs.10,000/- to Rs.12,500/- and other allowances-annual contingencies/air fare, dissertation charges etc...

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN PONDICHERRY UNIVERSITY AND SOUTH ASIA FOUNDATION-INDIA

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 19th March 2022 between the South Asia Foundation-India, a secular, non-profit and non-political organization, located at A-33 Vasant Marg, Vasant Vihar, New Delhi 110057, hereinafter referred to as "SAF", on the one part,

A 7. Chairman

South Asia Foundation-India New Delhi-110057

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The Pondicherry University, a Central University, created by an Act of Parliament, located at Kalapet, Puducherry, hereinafter referred to as "University", of the second part (hereinafter referred to as "parties")

Sets forth the agreements presently reached and earlier in MoU dt.: 27-03-2010 between the parties relating to the establishment and functioning of UNESCO Madanjeet Singh School of Green Energy Technologies (UMSGET) and utilization of the funds received from South Asia Foundation-India.

1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SCHOOL (UMSGET)

- i) UMSGET, named after Madanjeet Singh, the founder of South Asia Foundation-India was established at Pondicherry University with the support of South Asia Foundation-India, with the objectives of imparting advanced education and conduct of research and other related activities in Green Energy Technologies and other related areas by instituting a separate Centre for studies in Green Energy Technologies, besides other Centres and Departments, as approved by the Academic and Executive Bodies of the University. The Department of Green Energy Technology under the school has been offering M. Tech programme in Green Energy Technology from the academic year 2010-11 and in the future to offer any other programme as it deems fit. This Department, for all administrative and other purposes, is a constituent unit of the University having all powers and functions to undertake its academic and administrative activities on par with other units of the University.
- ii) The Department of Green Energy Technology will have its own faculty. Apart from the core faculty, it will draw expertise available in the University Departments. The Department will also draw expertise from researchers from within India and abroad.

The UMSGET shall also have under the School, Centre for Nano Science and Technology which has its own faculty duly approved by the UGC.

iii) The Department of Green Energy Technology will offer annually at least 16 fully paid Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarships, including travel, board and lodging, and tuition fees, more clearly specified in clause 9 of this MoU to South Asian students, based on gender equality, two from each of the eight SAARC countries- Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka. The Department of Green Energy Technology/ University may, for reasons to be recorded, discontinue the scholarship to a scholar if he/ she is found to be delinquent towards studies and /or conduct is unbecoming. The resultant vacancy may be filled up as may be appropriate and feasible. The dismissals and the filling up resultant vacancies may be done with the approval of the Chapter Head.

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iv) This clause is limited to the continuation or otherwise of the SAF scholarship and does not in any way restrict UMSGET/Pondicherry University from independently enforcing its academic requirements or enforcing disciplinary action, where warranted, against any SAF Scholar as per the norms and rules in force and as applicable to all students of the UMSGET/University.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHOOL

UMSGET has been established with an aim to impart advanced education, conduct research, and perform extension/outreach activities in Green Energy Technologies, and related/allied Green Technology areas, including Nano Science & Technologies. UMSGET shall annually offer at least 16 (sixteen) Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarships for the SAARC countries.

3. ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE

The School, being an integral part of the University, will have the same structure as applicable for all other Schools of the University. However, the funding by SAF for the various activities of the School listed under Para 1 & 2 of the Agreement and their utilisation will be monitored by an Advisory Council with the constitution given below:

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- ii) The Advisory Council shall be responsible for monitoring the funds and advising on the utilisation of funds received from SAF-India. The Head of the Department, in consultation with the Vice Chancellor, shall convene the Advisory Council meeting as many times as may be required, but will meet at least once in a year. The meetings of the Advisory Council could also be held using tele-conference mode.
- iii) The Head of the Department, who shall be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor, and he shall be responsible for the entire functioning of the Department. He shall present the Annual Report, the Audited Accounts, and also present the next year's budget and activity plan for the approval of the Advisory Council. The Head of the Department shall be responsible for the entire functioning of the Department and all its academic and extracurricular activities including coordination of courses, research fellowships and public relations and effective implementation of at least 16 (sixteen) Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarships from the SAARC countries.
- iv) The term of the membership of the Advisory Council, other than ex-officio, shall be for three years, or the expiry of the MoU, whichever is earlier, and they shall be eligible for re-nomination.
- v) The quorum for a meeting of the Advisory Council shall be one third of the total membership of the Council.

4. ACADEMIC & ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF

Staff of the Department of Green Energy Technology under the UMSGET shall be appointed by the Vice Chancellor as per UGC norms and the expenditure in this regard will be borne by the University.

5. FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION OF SAF

- i) SAF had undertaken to contribute annually a sum not exceeding US \$ 200,000/- towards the establishment and operation of the School. The SAF's annual contribution would be based on the expenses of previous year and shall not, in any case, exceed the limit of US \$ 200,000/- or its rupee equivalent, whichever is less.
- ii) It will be paid by SAF into an exclusive bank account (with appropriate FCRA clearance etc.) in two or three installments during the year as per requirement and operated only by the Finance Officer of the University.

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iii) All expenditure shall be through proper approvals and sanctions of competent authorities. The interest earned on the funds shall be used only for the activities of the School and shall not be diverted to any other activity. All sanctions of expenditure, after approval of budget by the Advisory Council of UMSGET of University, shall be through the usual procedures adopted by the University as per University rules. Fellowships, tenure jobs and all expenditure of recurring and non-recurring nature shall be met either by the University from UGC grant or from the annual grant of US \$ 200,000 allocated by SAF-India conforming to, and on the items of expenditure specified under 'Scholarship Implementation Regulations' (Para 9). The MoU may be extended on terms and conditions mutually agreed upon by SAF-India and the University after completion of three years.

iv) The SAF Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarship Scheme shall be funded by the Madanjeet Singh Foundation (MSF).

6. SAF REGULATIONS

In conformity with the SAF Governing Council resolution adopted in 2002 at Beaulieu-sur-Mer, France, SAF shall not fund any project without at least a matching contribution in cash or kind against SAF's financial assistance. Before receiving due payments of subsequent instalment of funds, UMSGET shall submit an annual Audit report and a progress report of the School to the SAF-India for onward transmission to the MSF after verification. It is stipulated that SAF shall discontinue funding UMSGET in case the Centre fails to fully comply with SAF's cardinal objective of promoting regional cooperation as specified in this MoU.

7. UNIVERSITY'S CONTRIBUTION

To match with the SAF's contribution and in conformity with SAF Governing Council resolution of 2002, the University's contribution shall be

i) Space for construction for the School/Centre

ii) Faculty

- iii) Campus accommodation to the students and the visiting faculty
- iv) Internet, on-line journal access, Sports, Media resources, Medical Facility and any other assets of the University
- v) Any other logistic support needed from time to time
- vi) Other Academic, Administrative & support staff to the extent required, as provided in para 4 above.

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8. VALIDITY AND OPERATIONALIZATION OF THE MoU

This MoU shall become effective on the date on which the parties append their signatures to it and its validity is for three years. It shall be the responsibility of the University that this MoU is subject to examination by the Authorities of the University and of the relevant laws of the land and its confirmation that it has obtained all the requisite approvals, including the FCRA, if deemed necessary and or that it is exempt from any such approval.

9. SCHOLARSHIP IMPLEMENTATION REGULATIONS

- i) These Regulations are binding on the Centre and strict adherence to them is mandatory.
- ii) The annual grant of funds to UMSGET shall be provided for covering the cost of at least sixteen (16) Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarships, two each from each SAARC country. The Group Scholarship Scheme has two components, namely, '<u>Scholarship expenses</u>' and the <u>'Scholarship related expenses</u>' in the ratio of 70:30. The expenditure on 'Scholarship' component comprises:
 - a) Tuition Fees
 - b) Examination Fees, if any
 - c) Accommodation expenses
 - d) Mess expenses
 - e) Stipend
 - f) Yearly To & fro travel of admitted students
 - g) Special course expenses, if any
 - h) Field Trips
 - i) Any other related expenditure (to specify)

iii) In the <u>'Scholarship Related Expenditure'</u>, component, which must not exceed 30% of the total expenditure annually incurred on SAF scholarships, comprise:

- a) Books and journals
- b) Computation expenses, if any
- c) Extension Lectures
- d) Workshops/ Seminars
- e) Expenses on account of Advisory Council Meetings
- f) Contingency expenses
- g) Any other related expenses (to specify)

- iv) The Institute shall strictly adhere to the number of scholarships allotted, based on gender equality. The principle is to have a fair representation of all the chapters but if any Chapter is not represented for any reason, the Chapter Head may permit students of other chapters to fill up the number but not exceed the allotted number of students. SAF scholarships funds should only be spent on scholarships and scholarship-related expenses of SAF scholars and cannot be diverted or adjusted against any other purpose.
- v) No SAF funds can be spent on the construction of buildings and on infrastructures such as the purchase of equipment, repairs, maintenance, etc.
- vi) Any unspent amount of annual SAF grant in a year, or interest earned on SAF funds during the year, shall be carried over to cover the cost of SAF Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarships / Scholarship Related Expenses during the subsequent year.
- vii) SAF annual installment for the subsequent year shall be paid to the Institute on receipt of an authorized auditor's report, giving the names of students on Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarships and itemized details of the expenditure incurred on each scholarship during the year.
- viii) The UMSGET shall send its respective annual audit reports to the SAF-India chapter, New Delhi, for verification so that they conform to these Regulations before they are forwarded to MSF Trustees for release of funds for the next year.
- ix) In order to streamline the expenditure pattern, the following four formats are prescribed for submission by the Institute online:
 - (i) Format on scholar profile;
 - (ii) Half Yearly Format giving full details of expenses on 'scholarship' expenditure;
 - (iii) Half Yearly Format giving full details of 'scholarship related expenditure'; and
 - (iv) Utilization Certificate incorporating the 'scholarship' and the 'scholarship-related expenditure' for the whole year.

10. VARIATION IN THE TERMS OF MoU

The terms of the MoU may be modified, if and when required, by the mutual consent of the parties.



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11. EARLY TERMINATION OF THE MoU

Either party shall be entitled to terminate this MoU by providing the other party with three calendar months advance notice. The termination of this MoU, for whatever reason, will not affect the rights of a party, which may have accrued as at the date of termination and will further not affect any rights, which specifically or by their nature survive the termination of this MoU. In case of termination of the MoU all the assets acquired by the School shall become a part of the University.

In agreement with the above objectives and terms and conditions, this Memorandum of Understanding is hereby signed by the below-mentioned parties on this 19thday of March 2022.

This Supplementary Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 19th March 2022 between the South Asia Foundation-India, a secular, non-profit and non-political organization, located at A-33 Vasant Marg, Vasant Vihar, New Delhi 110057, hereinafter referred to as "SAF", on the one part,

PONDICHERRY UNIVERSITY PUDUCHERRY - 605 014.

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South Asia Foundation-Indi New Delhi-110057

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The Pondicherry University, a Central University, created by an Act of Parliament, located at Kalapet, Puducherry, herein after referred to as "University", of the second part (hereinafter referred to as 'parties') through which SAF administers its scholarship scheme, namely, the Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarship Scheme at the UNESCO Madanjeet Singh School of Green Energy Technologies (UMSGET) of the University,

Sets forth the terms of administration of the SAF funded Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarship Scheme, more fully elaborated in the main body of the primary MOU entered between the parties.

Brief Background

- Consequent to the amendments notified to the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act by the Government of India on 29th September, 2020, it has become necessary to make suitable changes to the operational aspects of the scholarship scheme to meet the amended provisions of the Act.
- The amended Section 7 of the FCRA Act prohibits 'transfer' of funds to an organization, the practice hitherto followed by the parties.
- 3. While the various components and the utilisation of the scholarships under the Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarship Scheme is outlined in Para 9 of the primary MoU entered between the parties, the modified procedures in the implementation of the scholarship scheme is stated hereunder.

Modified procedures of implementation of SAF Scholarship Scheme

- These modified procedures are made in accordance with Para 10 of the primary MoU which provides for 'Variation in the terms of MoU'.
- The University shall raise monthly/yearly invoice towards the components as stated in Annexure I under 70%-scholarship expenses of SAF scholars and the SAF-India shall settle the amounts specified in the invoices to the University account.
- 3. As for the living expenses of scholars is concerned under 70%-Scholarship expenses as stated in Annexure II, the University shall raise monthly/yearly invoices for the same and the SAF-India shall disburse the amounts directly to the individual bank accounts of SAF scholars.
- 4. All bills towards 30%-Scholarship-related Expenses of SAF scholars as stated in Annexure III, the University shall raise monthly/yearly invoices for the same, payment shall be made by SAF-Indiadirectly to the respective agents/University who raised the bills or to the SAF scholars directly, as the case may be.

In agreement of the above terms and conditions, this Supplementary Memorandum of Understanding, is hereby signed by the parties concerned on this 19th day of March 2022 and shall be valid for three years from the date of signing.

<u>Facts on reckoning of DDE posts on deputation basis in earlier DPCs into</u> <u>regular stream:</u> (ENCLOSURE-V)

The DPC in its meeting held on 08.02.2016 (Section Officer) has discussed in detail about the reckoning of DDE posts and also practicalities in accounting the chain vacancies. The committee unanimously recommended the following (applicable for all the posts):

The DPC has noted that the posts sanctioned for various cadres under Non-Plan, Plan, Specific Schemes and also from DDE funds shall be treated as one block. The Committee has also noted that the services of the employees appointed under DDE funds are covered for the purpose of pension and promotion and was treated as deputation without deputation allowance. Taking into account the complexity of various issues involved in such method of filling up of such vacancies, the DPC has recommended that the posts to be filled on DDE funds may be treated as regular for all purposes. Further it is also submitted that the above said matter was placed before the 124^{th} meeting of the Executive Council held on 16.02.2017 (Res.No.2017.124.30) and the Council has deferred the matter.

<u>Facts on reckoning of DDE posts on deputation basis in earlier DPCs into</u> <u>regular stream: (ENCLOSURE-V)</u>

The DPC in its meeting held on 08.02.2016 (Section Officer) has discussed in detail about the reckoning of DDE posts and also practicalities in accounting the chain

vacancies. The committee unanimously recommended the following (applicable for all the posts):

The DPC has noted that the posts sanctioned for various cadres under Non-Plan, Plan, Specific Schemes and also from DDE funds shall be treated as one block. The Committee has also noted that the services of the employees appointed under DDE funds are covered for the purpose of pension and promotion and was treated as deputation without deputation allowance.

Taking into account the complexity of various issues involved in such method of filling up of such vacancies, the DPC has recommended that the posts to be filled on DDE funds may be treated as regular for all purposes. The employees promoted earlier and reckoned against the DDE posts may also be treated as regular and they are deemed to be placed on probation from their date of promotion in their respective posts.

Accordingly, order was issued on 05.04.2019 that promotions made against the sanctioned post under University/Schemes/Grants/DDE etc., are combined together and as such the Officers/Staff who have been promoted earlier and reckoned against the DDE posts on deputation basis are treated as promoted on regular basis for all functional and operational purposes excepting for availability of approved sanctioned posts and reckoning against regular posts. Also, the salary of junior most promotees in the respective posts will be booked under DDE funds and also declaration of probation of the said Junior most promotees will be considered who are in the service at the time of reckoning him/her against the regular vacancy.

Hence, the salary of the employees within sanctioned strength has been booked under UGC funds and excess has been booked under DDE funds.

As on date all the promotees have been accommodated in the respective sanctioned posts and no promotee is booked against DDE post.
