2021 Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) Postdoctoral Fellowships

The call for 2021 Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF) is now open.

The MSCA-PFs are offered in the framework of Horizon Europe (2021-27) and target researchers (including Indian researchers) holding a PhD, who wish to carry out their research activities in France or other European countries, acquire new skills and develop their careers. The researchers from any field can apply for a MSCA PF to work on their own individual projects. While the fellowship supports purely academic and disciplinary projects, interdisciplinary research and innovation projects as well as intersectoral work are also encouraged. The researchers who would like to restart their career after a break from research can also apply for the fellowship.

The PFs cover living allowance (to cover the researcher's salary and national compulsory deductions); mobility allowance; family or special needs allowance (if applicable); research, training and networking contribution etc. for a duration of 12 to 24 months.

The last date to send in the proposals is October 12, 2021 by 17:00 Brussels time (20:30 IST).

The proposals submitted will be evaluated in November-December 2021 and the results will be announced by March or April 2022.
