“Centre for Women’s Studies, celebrated International Women’s Day 2023”

The Centre for Women’s Studies, Pondicherry University, celebrated International Women’s Day at the J N Auditorium. Prof. Gurmeet Singh, Honorable Vice-Chancellor of Pondicherry University, graced the occasion with his presence and inaugurated the function.

Dr. Aashita, Head (i/c) of the Centre for Women’s Studies, welcomed the gathering and briefed about the importance of women’s day celebrations in Indian Society. She mentioned that Women’s Day is one occasion where we can rejoice and celebrate woman and womanhood. It also needs time to dismantle the deep-seated patriarchal constructs that still restrict women from living the lives they want. She also mentioned that as a part of the celebrations, the Centre for Women Studies organized various competitions for the faculty, non-teaching staff, research scholars, students, and sanitation workers of Pondicherry University.

During his inaugural address, Honorable Vice-Chancellor Prof. Gurmeet Singh wished everyone a delighted Women’s Day and emphasized the need to create a society and culture where all women of the world are given their due rights. His speech primarily focused on the importance of bringing up a child with values. He insisted on educating the boys and making them more gender sensitive. He congratulated the team of the Centre for Women’s Studies for organizing a series of events on the occasion of Women’s Day.

In his talk, Prof. K Tharanikkarasu, Director (i/c), Studies Educational Innovation & Rural Reconstitution (SEI&RR), insisted that women would be happier if men celebrated this day. He stressed how womanhood must be observed daily and how their everyday contributions require more acknowledgment and appreciation.

During the felicitation address, Prof. Rajneesh Bhutani, Registrar (i/c), Pondicherry University, stressed the importance of women empowerment and gender equity for a sustainable society.

Professor B.B. Mohanty, the Dean of the School of Social Sciences and International Studies, congratulated the Centre for conducting such events. He emphasized how treating women and girls the right way can lead to a prosperous and happy society.


Some of the senior Faculty members, like Prof. Nalini J Thampi, Prof. Mumtaz Begum and Dr. Regina Sharmila Dass, shared their views on being a woman and how they witnessed progress in Society when it comes to the advancement of women in Society.

The cultural highlight of the event was an outstanding dance performance by Mrs. Shruti Myvannan Chokshi on the theme “Raksheeka – the Protector.” A short documentary titled “Celebrating Womanhood,” filmed by the Centre for Women’s Studies Post-Graduation students, was screened and received well by the audience. As a social experiment, the students went around the campus asking questions to the students and staff and made a beautiful compilation of what comes to each mind when they take a moment to think about womanhood. It was followed by the distribution of prizes for the various literary events and sports, and fun activities that were conducted in the first week of March for the women sanitation workers, research scholars, students, and teaching and non-teaching staff of the University. The events’

coordinators were also honoured with tokens of appreciation for supporting the Centre in making the celebration a success.

This week-long International Women's Day celebration by the Centre for Women's Studies of Pondicherry University was a big success. A vote of thanks by Dr. Kalaiselvi K. T. concluded the function.

“Centre for Women’s Studies organized a three days Sensitization Programme on “Youth Leadership Development & Social Justice” in collaboration with RGNIYD”

The Centre for Women’s Studies, Pondicherry University, the NSS unit of Pondicherry University, Puducherry organized a Sensitization Programme in collaboration with **Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD)**, Sriperumbudur on “Youth Leadership Development & Social Justice” from Pondicherry University.

Dr. Aashita, Head (i/c), Centre For Women's Studies, Pondicherry University welcomed the gathering. Prof. B. B. Mohanty, Dean of School of Social Sciences and International Studies, delivered the inaugural address wherein he emphasised on the need of such programmes for the betterment of youth who are the real agents of positive change in society. It was followed by felicitation address by Mr. Sathish Kumar, State NSS Nodal Officer, Puducherry.

Mrs. Sargunam, Consultant, Life Skills Management, Chennai who spoke on various aspects of life skill management including effective communication, time management, problem solving among others. The second session on "Constitutional Rights for Marginalized" was expertly handled by Dr. Gurminder Kaur, Head(i/c), School of law, Pondicherry University, where in she talked about the importance of law, its proper implementation, challenges to proper implementation, the various loopholes, strategies to employ to efficiently take use of the laws and policies. The next speaker was Prof. D. Sultana, Dept. of Physical Education & Sports, Pondicherry University. Who discussed about 'Yoga & Meditation' for youth with a practical session on yoga.

Prof. G Palanithurai (Rtd.), Department of Political Science and Development Administration, Gandhigram Rural Institute, Dindigul. He spoke on the importance of decentralization of power, ways to achieve economic growth for India among other relevant themes. It was followed by ideas shared by other resource persons such as Mr. Arul Rajesh, Panchayat president, Muthukapatti village who spoke on 'Developing Role models in Panchayti Raj Institution'. The next speaker was Mr. Varadharaj, Panchayat vice president, Muthukapatti village who spoke about the challenges faced while doing his job and how he overcame it. Mr. Selvaraj , Youth Volunteer, Kambur village stated that by involving the youth in Gram Sabha, we can bring a positive change to our society. Mr Sivarasu, Panchayat President, Prathampuram village was the next speaker who focused on 'Developing role models in Panchayti Raj Institutions'. The next

speaker was Prof. G. Palanithurai who shared his views on youth volunteerism in democratizing the community through local governance. The last session of the second day was by Prof A. Shahin Sultana from the Department of Social Work, Pondicherry University who spoke on 'Positive Youth Development'.

Mr. Sathish Kumar, State NSS Nodal Officer who told the young participants about the social responsibility of the NSS. This was followed by the talk by Prof. Latha Abel, Principal, Nursing College for Women along with Mr. Jayakumar, District Coordinator, ICDM, Villupuram who shared their ideas on role of youth in disaster management and also the various gender issues arising in disaster situations. Akanksha is the premier flagship programme of the Department which configures **Panel Discussions and Special Lectures** involving experienced industry practitioners, entrepreneurs, experts from the public sector, and tourism faculty members from across the country who also interact with the students of the Department. The resource persons representing the tourism, hospitality, and allied industries deliberated on the pertinent issues that impact their businesses and the prospects and challenges faced by the tourism sector. **Akanksha'23 was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Shri. K.Lakshminarayanan, Minister for Tourism, Govt. of Puducherry.** The function was held at the SOM Auditorium in the University campus on 3.3.2023. The inaugural function was presided by Prof.Gurmeet Singh, Vice-Chancellor, Pondicherry University. Shri.Parth Sathpathy, Founder Director, 5D Global travel Solutions, New Delhi, was the Guest of Honour. Dr..R.C.Anu Chandran, Head of the Department welcomed the gathering. Prof.P.Natarajan Head, Department of Commerce, PU and Prof.Y.Venkata Rao Dean, Students Welfare, PU felicitated the occasion. Dr.Sibi P.S. Faculty Coordinator for the event delivered the scope of the Institute- Industry Interface Meet, Mr. Gijo George, student coordinator proposed the vote of thanks.

The highlight of the inaugural session was the honouring of the alumni members of the Department who holds the Guinness World Record for the longest journey by scheduled public transport in a single country. Shri.K.Lakshminarayanan honoured Mr.Dhelepan G.V. and Mr.Adamsonraj for achieving the landmark crossing 35,614.99 km across India from 07 February 2021 to August 2021. The guests of Akanksha also lauded the creative pursuits and talents of the students. Apart from the Management Fest a Beach-Clean Up Drive was organized by the Department in collaboration with Swachatha Corporation, Puducherry. The Akanksha Cup Cricket and Football Tournaments had 22 teams participating from all the departments in the University.

In his presidential address Vice-Chancellor pointed out the need to make the beaches of Puducherry pristine clean keeping in view the preferences of hygiene conscious tourists. A concerted effort in that direction, Prof.Gurmeet Singh stated, could do wonders to the beach tourism spots. He added many serene beach zones have the potential to be world-class sites and there is a dire necessity to prevent it from becoming dump yards of wastes. He urged the Department of Tourism Studies to play a pro-active role in synergizing the activities of Ecology and Environmental Sciences, Green energy technology and other concerned Departments of the University to initiate pragmatic campaigns.

Minister for Tourism Shri.K.Lakshminarayanan evinced interest in consulting the Department for preparation of tourism projects that can be introduced in Puducherry.

He remarked that a SWOT Analysis for Puducherry tourism may be prepared by the Department. Shri.K.Lakshminarayanan also laid accent on designing programmes for strengthening the functional skill sets of the students. INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR PONDICHERRY UNIVERSITY ACADEMICS FOR RESEARCH ON NICHE TOURISM AND SACRED GROVES

The Research Paper titled Mapping the Ecological Space of Sacred Groves in the Niche Tourism Campaign of Puducherry, India: A Perspective Analysis authored by Dr.R.C.Anu Chandran, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Tourism Studies, Pondicherry University and Reena Esther Rani, JRF Research Scholar, Department of Tourism Studies, Pondicherry University was selected as organic study in the Critical Tourism Studies Asia Pacific Conference held in British University, Hanoi Vietnam. The Conference was organised by the Asia Pacific a globally renowned Tourism Research Forum Series. The conference was themed Tourism Metamorphosis: Creative Destruction and the Remaking of Tourism Geographies.

The organisers recognised the study as an organic work for exploring Sacred Groves in and around the destination Puducherry as having niche significance for being promoted as part of the sustainable tourism development agenda. The paper probed the sustainable and pragmatic ways which may leverage the participative vibes of tourists with an eco-motive to relish the sacred groves in and around the destination. Some of the crucial leads identified configured edutainment programmes, natural trails, and dynamic programmes namely bird watching, and trekking for spotting flora and fauna. The significant value-adds comprise creating awareness of biodiversity and educating the tourists about ecological problems. Sacred groves are forest regions venerated by attributing the flora and fauna to ancestral worship. People worship several folklore gods in the sacred groves. They also practice several myths and taboos. In addition, several animals' statues could be found in the sacred groves. Local people depend on the forests for their livelihood. Their day to day activities sometimes are also associated with it. In addition, it also promotes folk dances, folk arts, handicrafts, and folk music. The main aim is to conserve such sacred groves and protect biodiversity, cultural ecology, and also to protect the locals from several disasters. These groves provide shelter to animals, birds, butterflies, and other species and also to several endangered and endemic species. Sacred groves are generally undisturbed by human interactions. The groves mostly have flora of medicinal value which is popular for curing several rare diseases. The research was selected for presentation as it brought out the extraordinary potential of the selected groves of Puducherry which possess immense educational value and has the capacity to draw tremendous influx of nature buffs as well as researchers. The study attempted to chalk out the ways and means through in-depth quality research to safeguard and sustain them. Cultural ecology is posited in this work as an integral part of the sustainable development of tourism destinations. The research adopted ethnographic method of data collection and analysis. It helped to understand the ecological and cultural importance of the sacred groves as well as the need for preserving the same for posterity by gauging how far tourism can play a pro-active role in ensuring its protection by enhancing the awareness levels of the various stakeholders configuring the public sector, NGOs, local community, historians, environmental activists, and ecologists.

In a function held in the University, Vice-Chancellor Prof.Gurmeet Singh appreciated the recognition for the novel study conducted and offered commendations to Reena Esther for receiving the Early Career Researcher award for the work. Prof.K.Tharanikkarasu, Director, SEI&RR, Pondicherry University was present.

Leading our generation to a healthy, peaceful, and happy Drug Free - Puducherry

The community-based student peer educators' sentiments for a healthy Puducherry echo the objectives of the project "Towards a Drug Free Puducherry District" – a community-based project jointly undertaken by the Department of Social Work, Pondicherry University and Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE), Government of India under Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan, Launched on 6th April 2022, over a period of 12 months, the project sensitized faculty and students from higher educational institutions in Puducherry against substance abuse and alcoholism in Puducherry District. As part of the project, students from 10 higher educational institutions in Puducherry were trained as peer educators to mobilize women, youth, and at-risk groups in local communities to address the substance use-related issues faced by community members and to aid them in accessing psychosocial support services.

The villages of Periyakalpet, Solainagar, Keezhparikalpattu, Kottaimedu, Melthirukanchi, Sivaranthagam, and Kezhoor were selected for peer-led interventions in this phase of the project. Between December 2022 and April 2023, the students organized a series of activities in these communities such as awareness programmes, focus-group discussions with women, youth and self-help group (SHG) members, health awareness sessions, sports and rangoli competitions, and household KAP (knowledge, attitude, and practice) surveys.

The student peer-educators were felicitated by Prof. Gurmeet Singh, Hon. Vice-Chancellor of Pondicherry University and Prof. B.B. Mohanty, Dean, School of Social Sciences and International Studies, Pondicherry University. Prof. R. Nalini, Principal Investigator provided a brief summary of the project's major achievements. Professor Gurmeet Singh, Hon. Vice-Chancellor, Pondicherry University delivered the presidential address and tabled the project report for the period April 2022-March 2023. Felicitations were offered by Professor B. B. Mohanty and Dr. K. Anbu, Head (i/c) Department of Social Work, Pondicherry University.

The dignitaries distributed the certificates and medals to the student peer educators in recognition of their work and achievements in their communities. Dr. Iftekhar Alam, Assistant Professor and Co-Principal Investigator offered the vote of thanks. The felicitation programme was organized to recognize and commend the potential of youth in Puducherry under the Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan campaign towards reducing the demand for drugs, especially among children and youth for the creation of a healthy and youthful Puducherry.

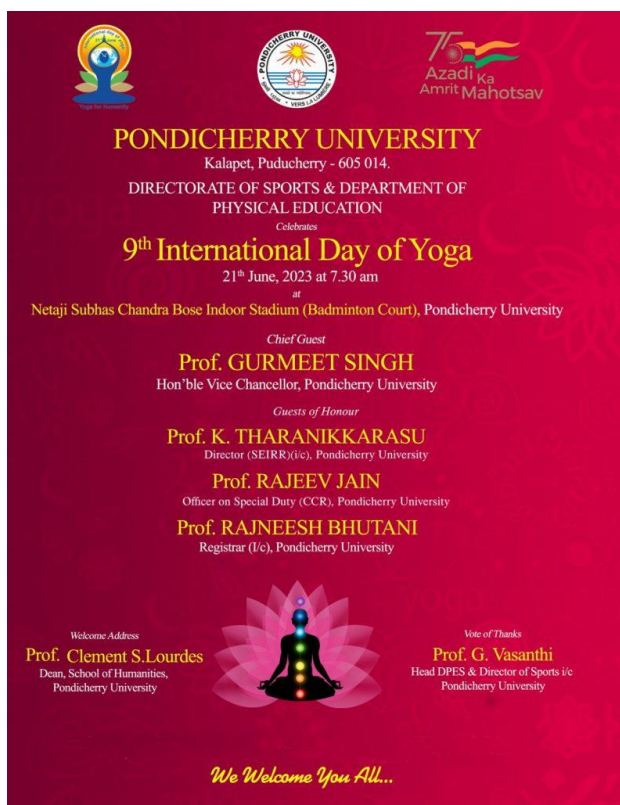

BACKGROUND

India is vulnerable to a variety of natural and man-made disasters. Disaster knows no boundaries and impacts everyone. Its impact includes the vast destruction of infrastructure, leaving people distressed with shaken inner strength. This impact, at times, changes the behavioral pattern of the affected and is very difficult to visualize. This largely depends on the degree of the dent created by the neighborhood and trained professionals. Often, such behavioral changes are mistaken for mental malfunctions. This thinking adds to the seclusion of an already distressed person.

Along with relief, rehabilitation, and care of physical health and injuries, psycho-social and mental health issues are also essential and must be prioritized. Psycho-social support in the context of disasters refers to comprehensive interventions that address a wide range of psycho-social problems arising in the aftermath of a disaster. Psycho-social support comprises general interventions related to the larger issues of relief work needs, social relationships, and harmony to promote or protect the psycho-social well-being of the survivors. Mental health services comprise interventions to prevent or treat psychological symptoms or disorders. These interventions help individuals, families, and groups restore social cohesion and infrastructure while maintaining independence and dignity.

The experience of disasters that have impacted various regions of India has revealed that Psycho-Social Support and Mental Health Services (PSSMHS) need to be planned ahead of disasters to be executed in a coordinated and integrated manner during disasters.

Psycho-social support for disaster-affected communities needs to be provided on a long-term basis. Appropriate and timely interventions will determine the victims' adjustments to various lifestyle changes caused by the disaster.

The interventions must be community-based and culturally sensitive, considering the needs of vulnerable groups like women, children, the elderly, the disabled, etc. Such support can relieve the psychological distress of the affected people to a significant extent.

PSYCHO-SOCIAL SUPPORT

Psycho-social support in the context of disasters refers to comprehensive interventions that address a wide range of psychosocial and mental health problems arising in the aftermath of disasters. These interventions help individuals, families, and groups build human capacities, restore social cohesion and infrastructure, and maintain their independence, dignity, and cultural integrity. Psycho-social support helps in reducing the level of actual and perceived stress and in preventing adverse psychological and social consequences amongst disaster-affected communities.

India, due to its unique geo-climatic conditions, has been experiencing natural disasters like earthquakes, tsunamis, cyclones, floods, droughts and landslides. The country is equally vulnerable to man-made disasters like chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear emergencies. Disasters, whether natural or man-made, cause enormous devastation and human suffering to the community. These disasters usually leave a trail of human agony, including loss of human life and injuries. Emotional trauma, and loss of livestock, property and livelihood, resulting in long-term psychosocial and mental health problems. Apart from logistic and material help, the affected community requires Psycho-Social Support.

Importance of Psycho-Social care in Disaster management

For a considerable amount of time, the direction of disaster management efforts was focused on the physical impact of the disaster. Only after international human rights agencies brought awareness did psycho-social care in disaster management become part of rescue and rehabilitation manuals. Disaster's psychological impact is considered a forte of trained psychologists. But very few need and can access these services based on severe cases like PTSD. The second objective of the workshop is to make participants aware of the relevance of psycho-social care in disaster management.

Psycho-social Care with Women

Disasters generally lead to migration, mass displacement, the spread of epidemics, and issues of social security, etc. Women are more susceptible to the impact of disaster management due to already existing issues pertaining to them. The third objective of the workshop will include practical difficulties in psycho-social support for women in disaster-affected regions. It focuses on an intersectionality approach, which emphasizes layers of identity. Social, economic, and political vulnerabilities of women and inferior genders worsen with the advent of disaster.

Psycho-social Care with Children

Children lack the social and language skills to express their agony and difficulties. It becomes more severe in terms of psychological impact. Psycho-social care with children in disaster management areas includes several practical difficulties. Losing a loved one/family member/parent in a severe disaster also leads to generational traumas.

Not providing adequate psycho-social care for children suffering in case of disaster will lead to significant life challenges for them in the future. The workshop will inculcate orientation with experts in child psycho-social care.

Psycho-social care with marginalized / vulnerable populations: intersectionality, accessibility, rehabilitation.

The impact of disaster experienced by communities differs across their standing in the social, political, and economic ladder of society.

Navigating through rural and urban populations:

Community participation is more in the rural region due to its size and social connectivity. While people in urban spaces are more vulnerable to mental health issues due to hectic lifestyles, lack of socialization, alienation due to the nuclear nature of families, etc., in terms of psycho-social care, these elements play an essential role in the approach to psycho-social support caregiver.

Role of social worker/ Strength Perspective:

Social worker plays a multifold role in disaster management. The workshop will help social work educators, practitioners, and learners understand their role in these situations. Psycho-social care is an interdisciplinary approach, so it is essential for social workers. Very few social work educators are trained in Psycho-Social Care in Disaster Management. So this workshop will be more beneficial to the Social Work Educators.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The key target audience for this programme will be faculties from social science background and social work practitioners from Southern India. Preference will be given to social work educators. A maximum of 40 participants will be enrolled for the Five (5) days of TOT on Psycho-social support and care.

AIM OF TRAINING

Aim of this training programme is to build the capacity among the Social Work Educators and practitioners on basic concepts of disaster risk management and strengthening the mechanism for effective psycho-social care in disaster management.

OBJECTIVES

1. To explain the basic concepts of Disaster Management
2. To understand varied needs of the survivors of disasters
3. To reflect upon the need for psycho-social care in disaster related work
4. To develop an understanding of how people react in stressful situations
5. To understand varied needs of the survivors of disasters
6. To develop an understanding of holistic caregiving approach
7. To understand the role psycho-social care givers need to play
8. To internalize techniques of psycho-social caregiving while working with children
9. To develop an understanding of needs of women in disasters and understand the role of women in disaster
10. To understand the importance of self-care and gain knowledge about skills on taking care of self while working in stressful situations.

According to the Companies Act of 2013, appointing at least one independent women director is mandatory for India's top 1000 companies listed in Indian stock markets. Subsequently, Indian corporate started appointing women in the boards from a mere 6% in 2014 to 17.6 % in 2022. Though the presents of women in boardrooms is increasing,

their representation is not satisfactory as it is only 1 % increase over the last three years. It implies that the Indian corporates have not attained gender parity yet. Therefore, the seminar aims to assess India's current position in achieving the United Nation Women's strategic plan report 2022-25 and the United Nations Organization's fifth Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) of gender equality.

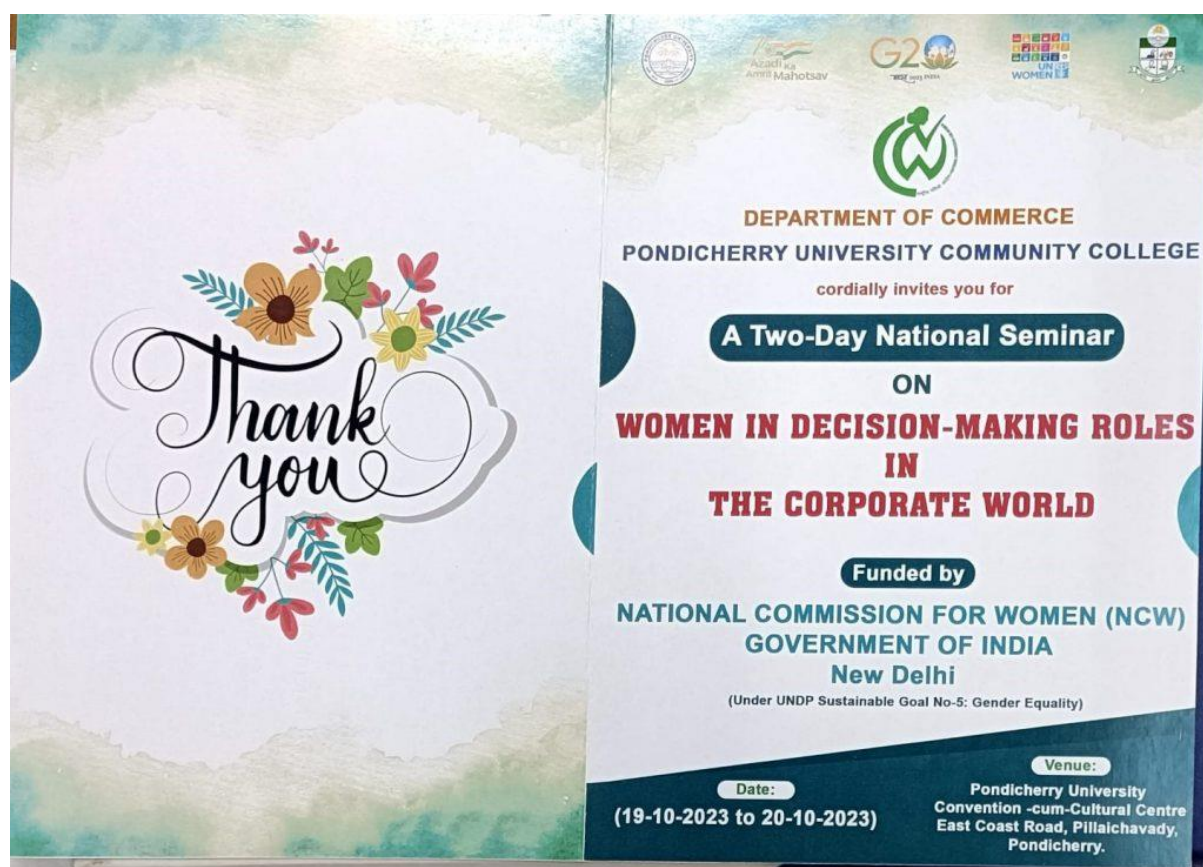

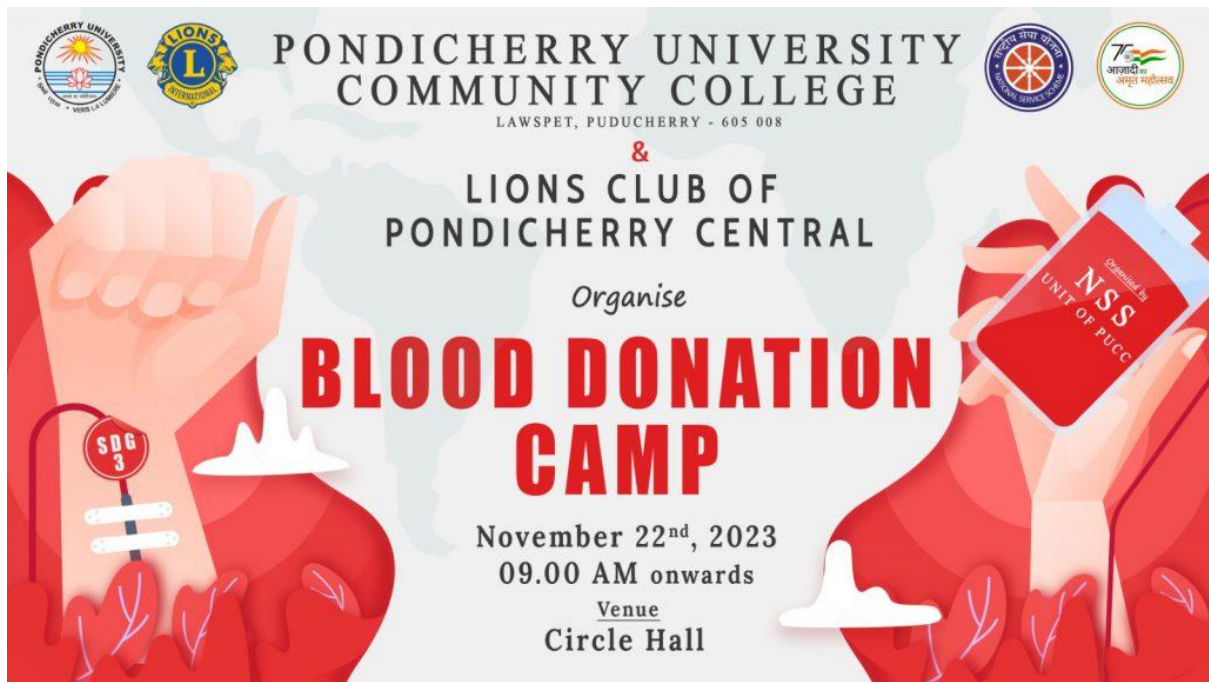

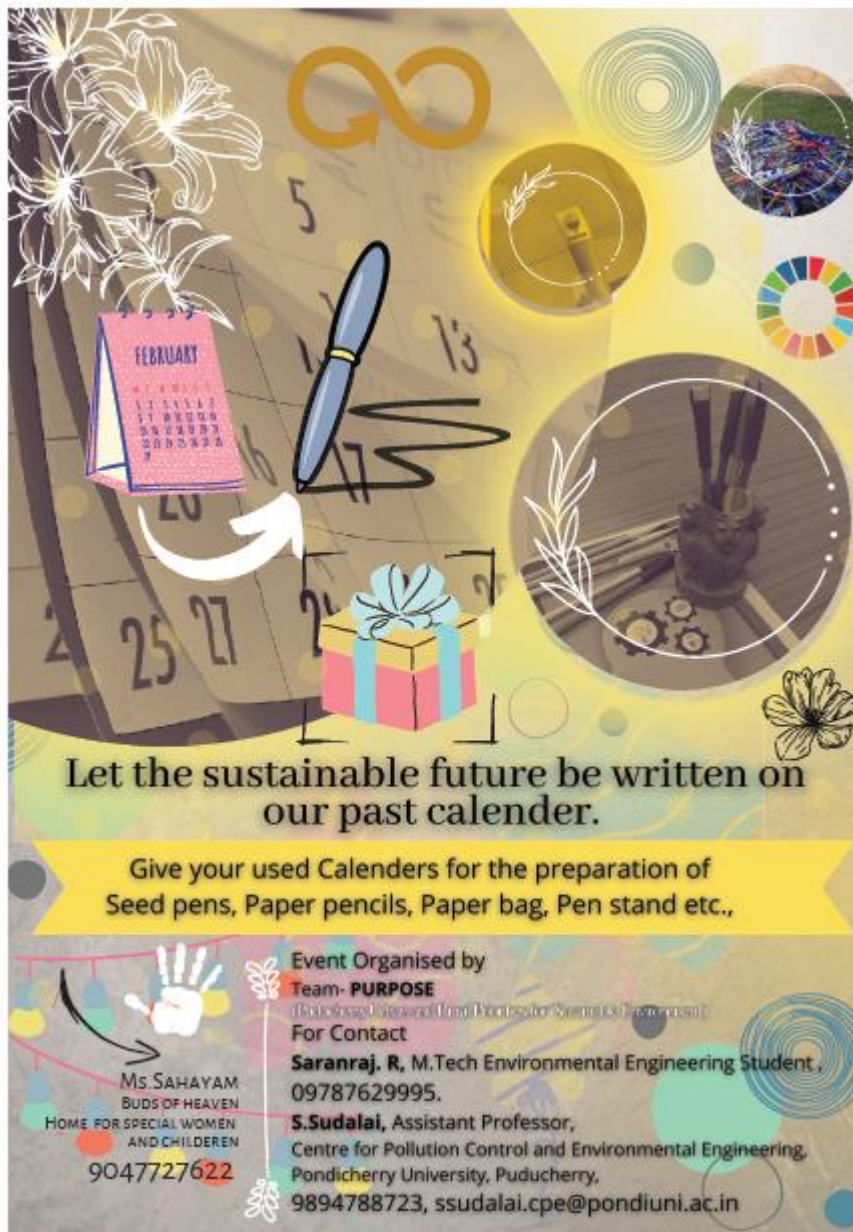
