Puducherry students profile two of Chennai's landmarks

First-year students from the History and Education Departments of Pondicherry University have completed their fieldwork at two distinguished heritage institutions in Chennai – the Government Museum and the C.P. Ramaswami Aiyar Foundation. The students worked alongside curators, archivists, conservation scientists and preservationists. They documented centuries-old manuscripts, assessed exhibits, and carried out oral history interviews with the help of the experts, a press note from the university said. The fieldwork, which is a feature of the National Education Policy (NEP) curriculum, positions the university as one of the first examples of field-based research in Museology, History and Archaeology in India, the university said.
