Training Program on ‘Women Leadership and Local Governance: Facilitating Inclusive Policy Through Viksit Bharat on 30/01/2025

Capacity building program enhancing women’s leadership in local governance to advance SDG 5 gender equality targets through Viksit Bharat framework.

The one-day training program on Women Leadership and Local Governance through Viksit Bharat, held 30 Jan 2025 by Centre for Study of Social Inclusion, Pondicherry University, empowered 76 women panchayat leaders. Activities included sessions on ethical leadership, transparent administration, Gram Sabha participation, resource management, and inclusive policy-making. Panel discussions featured dignitaries addressing women’s empowerment in local development and self-reliance through self-help groups. The program emphasized income generation, community accountability, and participatory decision-making at household and panchayat levels. It directly aligns with SDG 5 targets 5.5 (women’s leadership participation), 5.A (economic resources access), 5.B (enabling technology), and 5.C (gender equality policies). By building capacities for responsive governance, it supports SDG 16.7 (inclusive decision-making) and SDG 4.7 (sustainable development education).

साहित्य और सिनेमा में मछुआरा समाज और संस्कृति का चित्रण
Portrayal of Fisherman Society and Culture in the Literature and Cinema

मछुआरा समाज का यज्ञ प्राचीन काल से ही भारतीय समाज में विद्यमान रहा है। यह समाज काफी शांति-पिय भी रहा है। भारतीय सामाजिक संरचना में सभी वर्गों का अपना महत्व और योगदान है। मछुआरा समुदाय भी भारतीय सामाजिक संरचना का अभिन्न अंग है। आधुनिकता और विकास के क्रम में कई समुदायों के समक्ष रोजी-रोटी के साधन छिन जाने का भय, रोजगार पर बड़ी पूंजीवादी ताकतों का हमला, प्राकृतिक और कृत्रिम विपर्यस्त के कारण विस्थापित होने का डर तथा बुढ़ापे में स्वास्थ्य सामाजिक असुरक्षा आदि की समस्याएं भी उपस्थित हो रही हैं। मछली व्यवसाय के क्षेत्र में श्रमिकों का हाल बेहाल है, यहाँ केवल रोजी-रोटी की नहीं बल्कि अस्मिता और सांस्कृतिक अस्तित्व का भी संकट है। मछुआरों का भी संघर्ष-पूर्ण और व्यापक इतिहास रहा है, जिसके प्रमाण केवल इतिहास में नहीं पौराणिक कथाओं में भी मिलता है।

भारत के परिप्रेक्ष्य में मछुआरा समुदाय को कई नामों से जाना जाता है, जैसे मांझी, कैवट, निषाद, मल्लाह, धीवर आदि। ये लोग विशेषकर अपने पारंपरिक पेशे से जुड़े हुए हैं। मछली पकड़ना, मछली पालन करना और उसे बेचना ही इनका प्रमुख कार्य रहा है। इस तरह हम देख सकते हैं, हमारे यहाँ समुद्री और अंतर्देशीय नदी, तालाब एवं झरना अर्थात् मोटा-मोटी तौर पर कहे तो खारे एवं भीड़े पानी के यहाँ मुख्य रूप से मछली पकड़ने के ही प्रमुख स्रोत हैं, जिन पर मछुआरा समाज मछली पकड़ने के लिए सदा निर्भर है। समुद्र किनारे पर जो मछुआरे पाए जाते हैं, उनका मछली पकड़ना व्यापक व्यवसाय बन चुका है। लेकिन आज भूमंडलीकरण के दौर में उनका पारंपरिक पेशा छिनता चला जा रहा है, क्योंकि आज गड, पोखरों, नदी से लेकर समुद्री तटों तक पूंजीपतियों का कब्जा होने लगा है। इसी दृष्टि से हाशिए समाज में रहने वाले मछुआरों से संबंधित उपन्यास लेखन का कार्य एक सवाल-नवादी नजरिये से वंचित वर्ग के ही अधिकांश उपन्यासकारों ने किया है। मछुआरों की संवेदनापूर्ण समस्याओं पर विचार-विमर्श की बड़ी प्रासंगिकता है।

FAO Special Goodwill Ambassador for Nutrition, said that in an example of positive change, the African Union’s Pan African Parliament, “has collaborated with FAO to develop a model law on food security and nutrition. This model law serves as a guiding framework, inspiring African Union member states to formulate their own legislation that upholds the right to adequate food as well as food security for all citizens. To facilitate the transition from this model law to concrete legislative action, parliamentary alliances have been established across

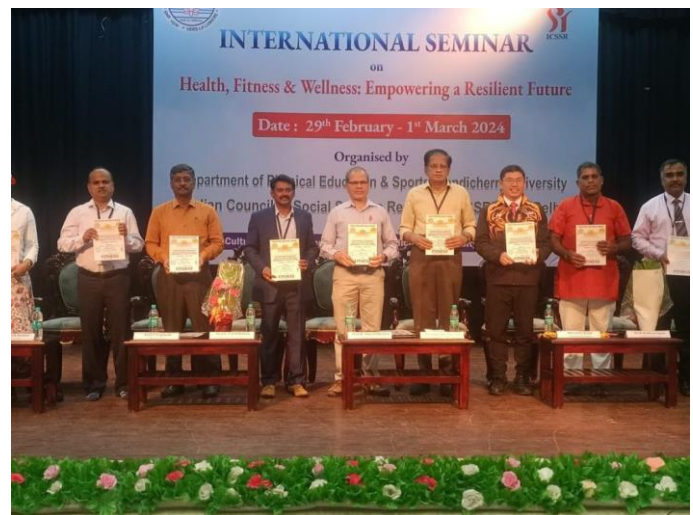





There is lack of awareness regarding kidney health among population as well as health care providers. There is poor utilization of eGFR (estimated glomerular filtration rate) and urinalysis (albuminuria or microscopic hematuria) testing by primary healthcare providers and physicians, even in high-risk individuals leading to missed diagnosis. 



A whole blood donation takes about 8-10 minutes, during which you’ll be seated comfortably or lying down while approximately a pint of whole blood is collected.

For a Power Red donation, a device will use a single-use kit to collect two units of packed red blood cells and return your plasma along with saline through the same sterile needle in approximately 45 minutes.





He has also participated in several National and International workshops and training programs of Epigraphy, Inscriptional languages and scripts, Manuscriptology etc organized by ICHR at IIT Gandhi Nagar, Tamil University, Thanjavur, Jnanu Pravaaha, Varanasi; Department of History, Calcutta University, Kolkata, Department of Sanskrit, Vijnana Bharati, West Bengal and Sarada Peetham, Sringeri, Karnataka.

He is a prolific writer and published more than 25 books on various topics of History, Epigraphy, History, Biographies etc in Malayalam besides and equal number of articles in English on the same topics. He gave several popular lectures and radio talks on topics related to the regional history.

He was a Member of the American Oriental Society (2019); Life Member, Linguistic Society of India, Deccan College, Pune; Life Member, South Indian Numismatics Society, Chennai; Life Member, South Indian History Congress & Life Member, Epigraphical Society of India.
